
Dear Mr. Radcliff:

This is to notify you that on July 17, 2008 the City's Public Safety Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that the revocation request by the Milwaukee Police Department for your Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license be approved with a suspension pending disposition of the charges pending against you in Milwaukee Circuit Court, rather than a revocation.

On July 21, 2008 you were personally served with a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license in which the Committee recommended that your license be suspended. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of July 30, 2008 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Public Safety Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee by a vote of fourteen (14) Ayes and one (1) Excused to suspend your license pending the disposition of the criminal charges against you.
