

PROPERTY DONATION

1254 North 24th Street: A 2,912 square-foot, three-unit house. The house is on a 5,000 square-foot corner lot located in the Historic Lynden Hill neighborhood. The property is currently owned by US Bank, which desires to donate the property to the City of Milwaukee. After property donation, limited repairs may be undertaken using the Housing Infrastructure Preservation Fund. The house will be marketed with reduced units, and owner-occupancy will be required.
