Description of work

The applicant is a tenant at this building. She installed a sign above the storefront but failed to obtain a Certificate of Appropriateness or permit for this installation. The recently installed sign will be removed and a new face will be applied to the existing rooftop sign, installed before the historic district was created. The building owner wants the sign to remain.



The applicant will install the new sign face to identify her business Rena's Fashion Boutique and remove the recent sign above the storefront.


