Industrial Road Relocation Planning and Design



- Direct Supply to expand its campus along Industrial Road
- \$1,100,000 to contract out construction design for relocation



- \$1,615,000 Request
- Replaces 4,405 trees
 - 3,843 street trees lost to mortality
 - 562 trees impacted by paving/sidewalk projects
 - Maintains 98% stocking goal








Emerald Ash Borer Readiness and Response

- **o** \$1,000,000 Request
- Treats up to 14,000 ash street trees annually
- Provides excellent control for 2 years
- Evaluating 3-year treatment cycle option





Emerald Ash Borer Survey







• • • EAB ASH Mortality







- \$371,000 Request
- \$211,000 contract removals for Hazard Tree Assessment Option
- \$160,000 for 1.5 New Urban Forestry Technician FTE's
- Rapid increase in EAB projected



• Cost recovered Payments with interest over 6 years on tax roll

Concealed Irrigation & General Landscaping for Boulevards

- o \$500,000 Request
- Maintains Boulevard
 Irrigation Infrastructure












• • Contract Stump Removal

- \$500,000 Request
- Addresses <u>annual</u> gap of 1,300 stumps and reduces backlog
- 2017 Projected year end backlog of 1,427 stumps
- On-going request

• • • ROI – Potential Salt Savings

- o 2016 salt price is \$62/ton
- Average salting operation uses 1,200 tons
- \bullet 10% savings 120 tons (\$7,440)
- Savings for 40 salting events (\$ 297,600)



- o Fleet Major Capital Equipment
 - \$6,725,000 Request







Fleet

• Maintains fleet age of 11.7 year average

• Projects 41 vehicles, including 7 CNG refuse packers
