REASON FOR REQUEST:

Paul Ropel, an employee of the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works, was in the scope of his employment and a pedestrian near the intersection of North 35th Street and West Locust Street. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling eastbound on West Locust Street, disregarded the red traffic signal, causing a collision with another vehicle, which resulted in the front bumper detaching and striking the claimant. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Ropel sustained injuries to his low back and right leg. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$107,033.55.
