Company History

TJM Innovations, LLC was originally founded as Builder's Roofing and Supply (BRS), and was a supply company for roofing products. Among the products BRS sold was GutterStuff® Foam Filter. When I Joined the company in September of 2008, I had plans for other uses of the foam we supplied, and I envisioned a collaborative for other, innovative products; and TJM Innovations was formed.

My goal at TJM Innovations is to establish GutterStuff® as the leading brand in gutter protection, as well as bring new and innovative products to the retail market. We have developed, trademarked and patented other products, including the Cobzorb line, which includes Cobzorb Oil Absorbent, Cobzorb Paint Solidifier and our newest, and rapidly growing, Cobzorb Multi-Purpose Cat Litter.

In 2009, I changed our name to TJM Innovations, LLC, initiated the manufacturing of GutterStuff* in house, and purchased our first facility in Milwaukee, WI in which to base our operations. Within a year's time we outgrew this facility. This growth allowed us to move to our new and larger plant, which includes over 100,000 square feet of warehouse space.

In June, 2011 I became majority owner of TJM Innovations. In my tenure as President of TJM Innovations, my company has proven proficiency in establishing a solid brand in the retail marketplace, and we are continually acquiring large store chains for our products. I have acquired the exclusive manufacture and distribution rights for GutterStuff® Foam Filter. TJM is also the manufacturer and fulfillment center for 2 small businesses based in Milwaukee.

GutterStuff® is currently sold in many retail stores across the United States including Ace Hardware, True Value, Orgill, Do it Best, Orchard Supply Co, Meijer's and The Home Depot in Canada and the United States. Our brands are also sold on many popular internet websites such as Amazon.com, HeartlandAmerica.com, bigrocksupply.com, abcsupply.com and Meijers.com; as well as in the catalogs of Roofing Supply USA and ABC Supply Co., Inc.

We are presently meeting with representatives from large stores outside of the United States, including OBI in Europe, Rona in Canada and Bunnings in Australia.
