Dear Council Members:

State Farm Insurance alleges that on November 27, 2015 their insured sustained damages when a City sewer backed up into the basement garage of their property located at 4906 South 19th Street. Clamed damages total \$6,447.34.

Infrastructure Services Division (ISD) records indicate that on November 27, 2015, Sewer Maintenance responded to a call of a backwater at 4906 South 19th Street. They found that the City main sanitary sewer was clogged with heavy grease and paper products. A sewer JetVac was used to open the clog, clean the sewer and restore it to proper working order. Due to the heavy grease found, the ISD placed the sewer on a special cleaning schedule. Their records also indicate that the sewer had been on a regular cleaning schedule and was last cleaned, prior to this incident, on April 29, 2013. Because the sewer had been on a regular

cleaning schedule and the City did not have notice of problems with the sewer, the City cannot be held liable. Therefore, we recommend that this claim be denied.
