There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines: Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.



Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.



The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/13/09 at 12:43 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 4747 N Hopkins St for an Armed Robbery complaint. Police attempted to enter the tavern but found the door locked. Police identified themselves and the bartender walked over to the cash register and buzzed the door allowing officers in. The bartender, identified as Theordis Terry, pointed out the victim and officers spoke with him. Investigation revealed the victim won some money while at the Potowatomi Bingo and had been at a couple of other bars before coming to Ealy's. Once at Ealy's, he bought a round of drinks. The victim stated he started talking to a girl who was with a guy or two and around 12:30 am he left the tavern. While walking to his car, the victim stated he could hear the girl talking on her cell phone telling someone he was leaving. Officers spoke with Annabelle Ealy regarding the entry door being locked and Ealy stated she keeps it locked for her safety and buzzes patrons in after she gets a look at them.  On 05/16/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at Ealy's 00 (4747 North Hopkins Street). Officers verified that the business had the licenses displayed.

6. On 01/17/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 4747 North Hopkins Street (Ealy's 00). At 1:35am there was a fight in the rear parking lot of the business. During the fight a subject was struck in the head with a pistol. The victim attempted to flee when an unknown armed suspect fired several rounds at the victims vehicle, striking the vehilce several times. Officers recovered 10 spent casings in the rear of the business. The agent stated it was motorcycle club night. The agent also stated she doesn't have security and the motorcycle club provides their own security.

7. On 03/22/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a t tavern check at 4747 North Hopkins Street (Ealy's OO). No violations were observed.

- 8. On 05/17/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shooting outside of Ealy's OO (4747 North Hopkins Street). PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Tiffany KOCH assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift. It should be noted that I did not personally respond to this incident, this narrative is a summary of the officer's reports that were on scene.

On May 17th, 2015 at 1:37a.m. several squads were dispatched to a Shooting complaint that was discovered to have originated directly outside Ealy Oo's tavern located at 4747 N. Hopkins St.

The investigation revealed that an intoxicated male (JEFFRIES, Matthew F., b/m, 5/1/85) was upset that his girlfriend (Keishana S. MCDONALD, b/m, 11/5/93) was kicked out of Ealy Oo's for starting a fight inside of the location. The subject ran into a crowd on the sidewalk in front of the bar and began an argument with the patrons who became upset that he had run into them. An unknown subject fired shots at JEFFRIES, and he was struck. JEFFRIES then went up to a van that was stopped in traffic facing northbound near Ealy Oo's. He later confessed to obtaining a firearm from one of the subjects in the vehicle and was observed on video pointing the firearm in the direction of where the shots that had hit him came from. JEFFRIES was arrested for felon in possession of a firearm and a VOP. An unoccupied parked vehicle was also struck by gunfire during this incident.

Squads were unable to immediately retrieve video from Ealy Oo's but video evidence was recovered from this location at a later date.

This report is written by PO Tiffany KOCH assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift.

On Thursday, June 11th, 2015 while assigned to sq. 7464, I was on patrol in the 4700 block of N. Hopkins St. At approximately 10:15p.m. I observed a black male subject cross the street from the sidewalk of 4747 N. Hopkins St. (Ealy Oo's) carrying three pink colored beverages in plastic ups with straws in them across the street and attempt to enter the bar Gold Diggers at 4750 N. Hopkins St.

I stopped the subject who was later identified as Darryl J. BALL (b/m, 2/12/93) who stated that he purchased the drinks at Ealy Oo's because they were cheaper than buying them at Gold Diggers. BALL stated that the drinks did contain alcohol.

I spoke with the bouncer of Gold Diggers, Alonzo P. GREER (b/m, 11/8/66) who did not let the subject in with the drinks. He stated that the drink prices are a lot higher in their bar than Ealy Oo's so people try to bring drinks over from there once in a while.

I then went to Ealy Oos and observed there was a security guard at the main entrance. His attention was focused on his phone when we walked in. He identified himself as Phillip D. ELLIS (b/m, 8/12/89). ELLIS stated that no one walked past him with any drinks while he had been there, and he had been standing there since the bar opened.

I then spoke with the bartender, Ayanna G. ALLEN (b/f, 11/14/71) who stated that she did sell three pink colored drinks containing alcohol to a subject shortly before we came in, but she did not observe him leave the bar with them.

I then went and spoke with the bouncer (ELLIS) again, and questioned him about this incident. While I was speaking with him, BALL came back across the street and tried to get into the bar. I asked BALL how he got the drinks out of the bar and he stated that the bouncer (ELLIS) was on his phone and didn't notice him leaving with the drinks. ELLIS was advised regarding this incident.

On Sunday, July 19th, 2015 at 1:24a.m. while assigned to sq. 7464, I along with sq. 7231 (PO BARTOL and PO BALL) and sq. 7211 (PO BRACHETT) were dispatched to a Shot spotter call at 4747 N. Hopkins St. (Ealy Oo's).

Upon 7231's arrival, PO BALL observed an armed security guard in the doorway of Ealy Oo's and had asked him if he had heard any gunshots. The security guard stated no and that no one had been shooting out there. That security guard was later identified as Phillip T. ELLIS (b/m, 8/2/89, 4247 N. 27th St. #12, ph#519-1783).

I arrived at Ealy Oo's at 1:29a.m. I then checked the front sidewalk area along with sq. 7231 and 7211 for casings, but we were not able to locate any.

I then spoke with the security guard, ELLIS. ELLIS stated to me that he had heard two gunshots but he did not know where the shots were coming from. ELLIS stated that just prior to the shots there was a large fight in the bar and he was trying to break it up and kick people out. ELLIS stated that he is the only security guard there and that the owner (Annabelle EALY) refuses to hire any more from her company. I asked ELLIS if he had called the police when this incident happened and he stated that he did not.

I then spoke with the owner, Annabelle EALY, inside of the bar. It should be noted that the bar area was empty except for a few workers, the owner, and security guard. EALY stated that there was a fight in the bar between some females and when they kicked everyone out someone started shooting. EALY stated that she did not know who did the shooting. I asked EALY if she had called the police, and she stated that she did not. EALY originally stated to me that she thought a bullet came through the window. After looking at the window, she stated that she had already filed a report on that bullet hole and that there no new holes in the window. I then confirmed with EALY that none of the rounds fired had struck the building, at which time she verbally said 'no' and shook her head.

It should be noted the bartender, only known as "Baby" (PH#639-0571) was not on scene upon our arrival and EALY was unable to reach her by phone

As myself and the other squads with me were just about to leave the premises, a call for a Shooting complaint was called in at St. Joesph's hospital and it stated that it was related to the shots that were fired at 4747 N. Hopkins St.

Sq. 7352 (PO MONIGOLD) responded to St. Joseph's Hospital regarding and determined that the subject was not shot, but cut by glass. PO MONIGOLD stated that the victim (Jabre R. BRODY, b/f, 8/15/1994) stated she and some friends arrived at the bar at 11:30a.m. She stated that at some point she exited the bar to locate her friend outside. She observed there to be an argument and physical fighting going on so she went back inside the bar to avoid the fight. She stated a few minutes later she heard gunshots from outside and saw glass from the window coming at her face. BRODY fell to the floor and found that she was bleeding from her face. Believing she was shot, BRODY was then conveyed to St. Joseph's hospital by her friends and treated for her injury. **It should be noted that BRODY is not of legal drinking age**

I observed one security guard posted outside of the location. It should be noted that I observed the guard enforce license checks and pat downs for weapons. This same guard was armed.

The owner, Ms. Rupert-Ealy, took the officers and the DNS inspectors on a tour and was willing to allow the inspectors to view locked rooms to check equipment.
