WILKINS M/B 09/01/98 of 3526 W Sarnow St. Milwaukee WI 53209. WILKINS is 17 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco. A photo of WILKINS was taken at the beginning of the assignment for identification.

At approximately 9:30A, WILKINS entered Mid City Liquor, located at 1935 W. Center St., and purchased a White Owl Very Berry Flavored Cigar. WILKINS provided a description of the cashier that sold him the tobacco. I entered the store and spoke with the cashier that matched the description. The subject was identified as Jerome S. CAMPBELL B/M 07/16/62. CAMPBELL admitted to the sale and apologized.

CAMPBELL was advised an enrollment letter for the M.A.R.T.S. program would be mailed to the agent.


The store is open daily from 8 am - 9 pm

The store has a prior agreement with the Hephatha MICAH core team to not sell liquor during times when children may be coming and going from the nearby Hopkins Lloyd Community School. That agreement states that the store will not sell liquor between 8 am and 9 am, as well as between 2:30 pm and 3:30 pm on days when school is in session. There are signs posted regarding this. The new licensee does plan to continue to honor that agreement.

The store does contract with Beer Capitol, Johnson Brothers, and Beechwood for the purchase of their liquor and malt/beer beverages.

The security camera system provides very good coverage of the store, and store employees are well versed in operating the system.

There is one main entrance into and out of the store and that is also covered by the security camera system.


