The Department of City Development reports that the tax foreclosed property located at 1851 North 2nd Street, Tax Key No. 353-0828-000-2, is not suitable for use by a public agency or community based organization. The Department of City Development objects to the return of this property for the following reasons:

- 1. Property has been abandoned for several years
- 2. Property has had outstanding code violations for several years
- 3. Property has been a blight on the neighborhood for several years
- 4. Ownership group is affiliated with Tim Brophy who has been in violation of City statutes for years and owns several properties that are unfit for human habitation.
- 5. Ownership group owns property at 1923 North 2nd Street that was demolished by the City due to its deteriorated condition.

This residential structure is vacant. Administrative costs incurred by our Department total \$1,878.93.


