PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Efrain Cornejo assigned to District Two, Early Shift CPU.

On Saturday, October 17, at 10:33 PM, while on squad 2266, P.O. Matthew Diener and I, along with squad 2212, Sgt. Tracy Tabiadon and squad 2268, P.O. Kevin Vodicka, responded to 1701 W Lincoln Ave (Divino Pancho's Restaurant) for a noise complaint. The caller stated there was music playing and patrons dancing. She stated the restaurant does not have a Public Entertainment Premises License (PEP). The caller stated the rear exit was opened and she could hear loud music.

On arrival, I observed the rear door was opened and I could hear the music. I observed there was a Disc Jockey (DJ) system on the stage. There was a laptop computer connected to speakers and lights. Officers observed a person manually playing music from the laptop.

I interviewed the licensee, Adriana Castelan (W/F, 03/05/74). She stated she was hosting a birthday party and she did not think she needed a PEP for a DJ or dancing. She stated she forgot to close the rear door when she was bringing some extra chairs in. Castelan immediately closed the rear door to prevent the noise from escaping the restaurant. I informed Castelan she would be getting cited for not having a PEP.

Attached is a photo that was taken of the DJ setup.

I checked the License Information Reporting Administration System (LIRA) and verified that Castelan did not have a PEP or a temporary PEP.

I cited Castelan on 10/19/15. She stated she made a mistake and only allowed the DJ system in her business because she did not want non-employees putting music on her system. Castelan stated her sound system was behind the register area and did not want any one back there. Castelan also admitted patrons were dancing at times.

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

This report is written by P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, assigned to District 2, Early Shift. On Sunday, May 24, 2015, at 5:59 p.m., Squad 2250 (P.O. LINDSTRUM/ P.O. VELASQUEZ) was dispatched to a Sexual Assault complaint at 2425 S. 13th St. #A. Upon arrival I spoke to Petrita J. GONZALEZ (W/F 12/17/80, 2425 S. 13th St. #A, 414-312-7671) who stated she went to Brothers Mini Mart (PG Mini Market) to purchase an oatmeal pattie and a couple of sodas. She stated the total was \$2.25 but the "owner", described as an Indian male, beard, glasses, in khaki pants and a plaid shirt, told her to only pay \$1 and give him a hug. GONZALEZ stated she gave the "owner" a hug but he leaned in and attempted to kiss her. GONZALEZ stated that as she pulled away the "owner" grabbed her left breast. GONZALEZ stated she wanted the "owner" to face his consequences because she did not consent to a kiss or her breasts being grabbed. GONZALEZ stated she wanted a citation issued.

P.O. LINDSTRUM and I changed location to PG Mini Market and observed the male described by GONZALEZ. He was identified as Amarjit S. DHALIWAL. DHALIWAL and his wife, Karamvir K. DHALIWAL, the store licensee stated that nothing occurred and that we could review the video. Squad 2290 (P.O. SAROSH) came to the location to assist with a translation. Amarjit S. DHALIWAL stated that he did not remember a woman enter the store and exchange a hug with him. He stated he did not kiss or grab a woman's breasts.

A check of the video revealed GONZALEZ was in the store and that a hug was exchanged. The video also showed that Amarjit S. DHALIWAL did attempt to kiss GONZALEZ but she pulled away. Due to the location of the camera I was unable to see if GONZALEZ's breasts were touched. Amarjit still stated he did not remember the encounter. Karamvir K. DHALIWAL stated her husband has memory issues.

I requested a copy of the video but Amarjit and Karamvir DHALIWAL were unable to provide one. P.O. SAROSH advised both subjects that every employee should know how to work the camera equipment and have the ability to provide officers with a copy. It should be noted that although the store's cash register is enclosed and had a partition to keep the clerks separated from the customers, the door to the enclosed area was open and so was the partition window. The licensee stated if I returned the following day they would provide me with a copy. I returned to the location at approximately 11:50 a.m. on 05/25/2015 and Karamvir provided me a USB of the video recording of someone recording the video surveillance. A copy was placed on inventory #15017780 at District 2.





Count 1: DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Ms. Garza stated that on Friday night 1/29/2010, she and the defendant were out at a bar and she saw the defendant drink several shots of tequila and the defendant was very argumentative with her and was calling her names. Eventually, they went to the Garza residence located at 1635 South 7th Street, City of Milwaukee, into the early morning hours of Saturday 1/30/2010 where the defendant, who was by now intoxicated, continued to be argumentative. He continued to call Ms. Garza names and he demanded that she leave immediately with the klds and he slapped her across the face causing pain without her consent. Then the defendant grabbed her and stated that he was going to "fucking shoot [you] right now;" her 9-year-old daughter Pricilla Garza, saw a gun handle protruding from the defendant's pants pocket so she called the police. Officer Jon DuChateau reported that he and other officers arrived and the kids let the police in. When officers went to the kitchen area where the defendant and Ms. Garza were, the defendant fled and Officer Robert Monette observed the defendant crouch down by clothes by the washerdryer. Officer Monette stated that the defendant then ran and Officer Monette recovered in the clothes where the defendant was crouched, a .357 gun, loaded. Further, an unloaded .22 rifle w/boxes of ammunition were found in the bedroom. Further, Officer DuChateau reported that the defendant was highly intoxicated; Officer Michael Monette reported that he conducted an intoxilyzer test on the defendant which revealed that the defendant, even 4 hours after his arrest, had a high blood alcohol content of .14. Officer DuChateau reported that Ms. Garza was crying and appeared frightened and distressed.


The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/15/2014 at 1:41am officers responded to The Toolbox Tavern at 1500 W. Scott St to investigate a subject with weapon complaint. The investigation revealed that at about 1:00am three subjects came into the tavern and started to play pool. They appeared to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol and were asked to leave by David TORRES (Authorized Rep of the business). An argument and fight occurred outside with one of the patrons and the three suspects. TORRES had everyone but the three suspects return inside and locked the door. The suspects returned with a bat and broke out the windows of vehicles parked in front of the bar. One suspect was identified as Jose ALVARADO. He was arrested for Damage to Property inc# 14-074-0012. The applicant was on scene and stated this incident occurred outside. She did not have any cameras on the premise.
- 2. On 11/23/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (Tool Box). Officers spoke to the bartender, Jennifer Rosiak, who stated she was unaware of any trouble. Officers made several attempts but, were unable to contact the caller.
- 3. On 12/19/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1500 West Scott Street. No violations were observed.

- 4. On 01/15/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1500 West Scott Street. No violations were observed.
- 5. On 04/02/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a fight/battery complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox). The bartender, Jennifer Rosiak, told officers a patron of the bar had thrown a bottle at her when she refused to continue serving him. The assailant, along with 2 additional patrons, was removed from the bar and had fled the scene prior to the arrival of officers.
- 6. On 04/09/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Tool Box). The bartender, Robert Fielbelkorn, told officers that a male and female had been arguing inside the business. Later, while watching the live feed of the surveillance camera, Fielbelkorn observed the male strike the female several times while they were both outside the building. The male then forced the female into a vehicle, which then fled the scene. Fielbelkorn then called police. The vehicle and both parties were located a short time later and the male was arrested. The officer observed no violations inside the business. Milwaukee police incident report #150990020 filed.
- 7. On 06/25/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a trouble with a subject complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox Tavern). The bartender told officers a customer had become disorderly, yelling obscenities and engaging in verbal confrontations with other customers, and was escorted out by other customers. The disorderly subject remained outside kicking the locked door and pounding on the window. After several minutes, the subject gave up and walked away. This subject was not located by officers, who observed no violations while inside the business.
- 8. On 07/05/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox). Officers determined the fight had dispersed prior to their arrival and no violations were observed inside the business.
- On 07/11/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint in the area of 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox Tavern). Patrons inside the business indicated the call had not been placed from that location and no sign of an altercation was observed. Officers were unable to locate the caller.
- 10. On 08/22/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shots fired complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox). A security guard for the business, Cory Boye, told officers he heard approximately 3-4 gunshots around 2:00am while closing down the bar. Officers discovered a pool of blood on the sidewalk on the southeast side of the building which they followed to 1308 South 15th Place, where they discovered Brandon Hervey. Hervey told officers he had been involved in a fight outside of The Toolbox, but he doesn't remember with whom. While investigating this incident, officers also responded to an accident at South Cesar E Chavez Drive and West National Avenue. It was discovered the operator of the vehicle, Gabriel Velazquez, had been shot. Velazquez died from his injuries. It was discovered that Velazquez had been at The Toolbox earlier, where he got into an argument with other patrons. Velazquez then gets into his car and attempts to run over the patrons he had argued with, one of which produced a gun and fired in the direction of the car Velazquez was driving. Milwaukee police incident report #152340037, #152340025 and #153240048 filed.

- 11.On 10/03/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1500 West Scott Street (the Tool Box). No violations were observed.
- 12. On 11/15/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1500 West Scott Street (the Tool Box). Officers discovered one patron who had not attained the legal drinking age of 21. This patron was cited and a letter was sent advising the applicant to enroll in the Respect 21 program.
