Workforce Organizational Reform Committee – Final Recommendations WORC Meeting Thursday, May 26th, 2016

Eligibility Requirements

Current

- Milwaukee resident
- Underemployed or unemployed for last 30 days
- Meet Federal "free lunch" income requirements

- **Proposed Change**
- Reduce unemployment duration to 15 consecutive days, including Saturdays and Sundays

RPP Certification Period

Current

 Resident retains RPP certification for 5 years

- Residents retain certification indefinitely but will be verified every two years
 - Verification to be done by new Economic Development Coord.
- Certification lost if residency and/or income criteria are no longer met

RPP Worker Information

Current

 The RPP list includes basic information such as names and addresses

- Include information related to the workers' trade and work experience
- Include and track information related to worker hours by zip code, race and ethnicity, and gender

Apprentices

Current

 Apprentices are not required to be RPP certified

- All apprentices must be RPP certified
- One quarter of required RPP hours must come from apprentices
- May also count towards the disadvantaged area requirement if applicable

Disadvantaged Areas

Current

 No requirement to hire residents from disadvantaged areas of the city

- One quarter of required RPP hours must come from workers in the CDBG area
- May also count towards the apprentice requirement if applicable

Incentives

Current

 No multiplier for exceeding specific requirements

Proposed Change

Hours above the required percentage for targeted groups will count for 1.5 hours

Missed Hours

Current

 Hours used from different projects to meet the requirements on the original project are not required to come from projects in specific counties

Proposed Change

Additional hours can be used to meet requirements on the original project by hiring RPP workers for projects within Kenosha, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha counties

Penalties

Current

 Penalties for noncompliance are different based on the type of contract (public works or private development)

- Standardize penalties for non-compliance
 - Fine of \$2,000 for both public works and private development projects

Utilization Plan

Current

 Resident utilization plans are not required for all contracts

Proposed Change

 City contracts exceeding \$1,000,000 will require a city resident utilization plan

LCPTracker Software

Current

 LCPTracker is required for development agreements that include RPP requirements and all public works contracts

Proposed Change

 LCPTracker is required for all projects with RPP requirements

First-Source Employment Program

Current

 A recipient of direct financial assistance shall require all of its contractors and subcontractors on a project to utilize the first-source employment program

- Employ Milwaukee will administer
- Retain 10 day threshold for announcement or advertisement to public
- OSBD will follow-up with Employ Milwaukee to ensure that outreach is being done

Performance Reporting

Current

- OSBD and DCD report to two committees on RPP performance for development contracts
- DPW reports to a different committee on RPP performance for public works contracts

Proposed Change

 One comprehensive RPP report presented at Community & Economic Development Committee with all departments present

Local Business Enterprise Certification

Current

 A business must own or lease real property within the geographical boundaries of the city of Milwaukee

Proposed Change

 The business must also operate in the city of Milwaukee

Small Local Business Enterprise Incentive

Current

 Local business enterprises receive a 5% bid preference

Proposed Change

 10% bid preference for local businesses also meeting small business enterprise certification requirements

"Disadvantaged with respect to business location"

Current

 Means location within an enterprise zone within the city for a period of not less than one year

Proposed Change

 Reflect that a portion of the city has received the designation of "renewal community" and not "enterprise zone"

Advisory Committee

Current

 Committee comprised of public and private stakeholders does not exist

Proposed Change

 Form an advisory committee that includes public and private stakeholders
