**Description of work** The applicant is proposing to replace an existing stair with a new stair at the rear of the

property. The stair accesses an apartment above the garage and is located at the south end of the building. The stair framing, risers and railing system are to be built of pressure treated southern pine. All treads and upper platform to be built of Azek. The balusters will consist of

2 x 2 square stock spaced 3 1/2 inches on center. The post tops will be pyramidal in shape. The wood portion of the stairs will be stained with oil based Sherwin Williams English Walnut

stain. The Azek portion of the stairs will come in a Kona brown color. Decking will have a

traditional square edge.


