

Sharain Horn BSN MSN SANE-A SANE-P is currently the Clinical Nurse Specialists for Abuse Response Services for Aurora Health Care. Sharain has fourteen years' professional experience as a Registered Nurse in the Milwaukee area. In the past fourteen years her experience includes ER nursing, SANE (Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner), Intimate Partner Violence Response, Safe Mom Safe Baby and Women's Health (both inpatient and outpatient setting). Her experience has allowed her to work effectively in the role of Clinical Nurse Specialists to address the needs of those affected by personal violence.

As the Clinical Nurse Specialists for Abuse Response Services, Sharain is responsible for education to the system around trauma informed care. This includes educating the caregivers on how to provide trauma informed care to the clients that they serve. This requires caregivers to understand that clients (and the caregiver) have had experiences prior to their interaction that may shape or impact how they interact.

Sharain is also responsible for education throughout the Aurora system around the topic of domestic violence and sexual assault for caregivers and providers. Sharain has developed educational materials for residents and medical students in the OB setting around the topic of screening and interventions for personal violence. Sharain also presents to nurses two all-day courses on domestic violence during the year and sexual assault education to nurses and providers. Sharain also presents during psychosocial nursing to discuss stages of change with those leaving or maintaining relationships that may be violent. Sharain also has presented at numerous community venues around the topic of domestic violence and sexual assault.

Sharain is certified as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner- Adult and Adolescent and as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Pediatrics. Sharain is currently working toward her certification as a Board Certified Forensic Nurse Examiner as well.
