The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

2. On 05/21/09 at 11:22 pm, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check at 7420 W Villard Avenue. No violations were found and all licenses were property displayed.

3. On 07/26/09 at 1:38 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 7420 W Villard Avenue for a Trouble With Subject complaint. Investigation revealed a fight took place inside the tavern between several patrons. A patron who was not involved then made comments to the parties that were fighting when one subject took a bat and began hitting the victim. The victim was uncooperative with police as to who struck him and refused to talk to officers. Police obtained statements from Quiana Milton and the bartender Melvin Lee regarding the incident.
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4. On 11/17/2011 Sheila D. Milton was charged in Milwaukee County with Use/Unauthorized Person in Food Stamps (<\$100/1st) §49.795(6). Sheila D. Milton is listed on the application as a 50% shareholder.

6. On 05/19/2013 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at 7420 West Villard Avenue (Dee's Elegance). Investigation revealed at least two subjects exchanged gunfire in the southwest corner of the business's parking lot. Milwaukee police incident report #131390010 filed.

7. On 04/06/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a battery-dv complaint at 7420 West Villard Avenue (Dee's Elegance). The victim had left that location, but was located a short time later. The victim, Phillis Coleman, told officers that she and Bryan Winters, who is the father of her son, were dancing at Dee's Elegance. Winters became upset with Coleman and pushed her to the floor. When Coleman left the club, Winters followed her and punched her once in the head. Milwaukee police incident report #140960012 filed.
8. On 06/10/2014 the applicant met with Milwaukee police and Assistant City Attorney Nick DeSiato regarding problems at Dee's Elegance. Nuisance ordinances were explained to the applicant who told officers she currently has a dress code, and that patrons are patted down. It was suggested that the club check all ID's, does not over serve and monitor capacity closely. The applicant indicated they are ordering a hand held swipe ID device and they had added three more sets of lights. Captain Beecher requested that the applicant submit a new plan.
9. On 06/22/2014 Milwaukee police were flagged down by security for Dee's Elegance (7420 West Villard Avenue). Officers were told that there had been a wedding party inside the business that had been arguing with another group of patrons. The wedding party was asked to leave the business, and had remained in the parking lot. Security believed that the wedding party may try to start a fight with other patrons when they left the business. Officers spoke to members of the wedding party who left the property a short time later without incident. No violations were observed.

10. On 01/26/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 7420 West Villard Avenue (Dee's Elegance). Investigation revealed a subject who was working security for the business had shot a patron when that patron pointed a gun at him. Milwaukee police incident report #150260003 filed.

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11. On 03/20/2015 officers went to Dee's Elegance, 7420 W. Villard Av, for a check with Wisconsin Department of Revenue agents. Agents located numerous bottles of alcohol that were not on invoices. The bartender stated they were gifts from customers or left over from private parties. The bottles were seized and a warning was given to maintain invoices on sight.
12. On 10/03/2015 officers were dispatched to Dee's Elegance, 7420 W. Villard Av for a Criminal Damage to Property investigation. The applicant was the caller and stated a customer left her establishment and walked across the street and intentionally damaged the fence to the business at 7501 W. Villard Av. The applicant provided video of the incident and her cooperation was pivotal to the investigation.
13. On 02/18/2016 officers were dispatched to Dee's Elegance, 7420 W. Villard Av, for a trouble with subject call. The applicant stated a customer was refusing to leave at closing time and was threatening her and her staff. The subject was on scene and told officers he was not leaving and they would have to arrest him or he wasn't leaving. He was arrested and conveyed to district 7 where he was cited for Loitering.

THIS LICENSE PREMISE REPORT IS WRITTEN BY P.O. RALPH MCCLAIN, ASSIGNED TO DISTRICT FOUR, LATE SHIFT. ON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2016 AT 2:08 AM, I, P.O. MCCLAIN, ALONG WITH MY PARTNER, P.O. MARTINEZ MOORE, ASSIGNED TO SQUAD 4365, RESPONDED TO A TROUBLE WITH SUBJECT AT THE LOCATION OF 7420 W. VILLARD AVE, DEE'S ELEGANCE LOUNGE. UPON ARRIVING, I SPOKE WITH THE OWNER/COMPLAINANT, QUIANA MILTON, B/F, 04-19-80, WHO STATED THAT A BAR PATRON, LATER IDENTIFIED, VIA WISCONSIN ID, AND VERBALLY BY THE PATRON HIMSELF AS VICTOR L. WEST, B/M, 01-20-74, 5027 N. 27TH ST, REFUSED TO LEAVE THE PREMISE AFTER THE BAR HAD CLOSED AT 2:00 AM. MILTON STATED WEST WAS TOLD TO LEAVE BY HERSELF AND SEVERAL SECURITY PERSONNEL BUT REFUSED. WEST STOOD IN THE BAR'S PARKING LOT AND YELLED "FUCK YALL, I AIN'T GOING A MOTHERFUCKING PLACE, YALL GONNA HAVE TO CALL THE POLICE ON ME". WEST ALSO MADE THREATS TOWARDS MILTON AND HER SECURITY PERSONNEL STATING THAT HE WAS GOING TO RETURN TO THE BAR AND KILL THEM. MILTON STATED WEST CONTINUED YELLING AND USING PROFANITY CAUSING A DISTURBANCE IN THE PARKING LOT OF THE CLUB. UPON SPEAKING WITH MR. WEST, HE TOLD P.O. MOORE AND THAT WE WERE GOING TO HAVE TO ARREST HIM AND TAKE HIM TO JAIL OR ELSE HE WASN'T LEAVING. MR. WEST WAS CITED FOR LOITERING (CIT #48468311 295), TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND CONVEYED TO DISTRICT FOUR FOR BOOKING AND PROCESSING.




PA-33E Narrative

This Report of Incidents Involving Licensed Persons or Premises, original report, was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS# 015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Saturday, October 3, 2015, at 2:55 A.M., Squad 4365, P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN and I, was dispatched to 7420 W Villard Ave. (Dee's Elegance) to interview the owner regarding a Criminal Damage to Property investigation. Upon our arrival, P.O. MCCLAIN interviewed the owner, identified as Quiana L MILTON B/F, 04-19-80 address of 5817 N 77th St; Milwaukee, WI 53218, cell phone#414-364-7112.

Quiana MILTON stated on Saturday, October 3, 2015, at approximately 2:25 A.M., she observed a patron leave her establishment then walk across the street to 7501 W Villard Av, identified as All Pro Transmissions and Autos. Quiana MILTON stated the former patron then entered the business grounds through an opening in the metal fence line. MILTON stated the subject, later identified as George E BANKHEAD B/M, 11-19-71 address of 8129 W Scranton Pl; Milwaukee, WI 53218, cell phone# 414-399-5751, entered into a white, 4dr, Cadillac Deville (WI plates of 623-VRG) that was parked on the lot. Quiana MILTON stated BANKHEAD then intentionally backed the vehicle into the fence, subsequently damaging it. MILTON stated that BANKHEAD pulled the vehicle forward, then intentionally backed the vehicle into the fence a second time, furthermore causing further damage to the fence. Quiana MILTON stated she immediately notified the police. MILTON stated this incident was depicted on her camera system.

I, P.O. MOORE, then watched the incident on MILTON'S camera system. The incident was captured on Camera#4. MILTON'S camera system is absent of audio. The incident was captured from afar, which directly affected the clarity of the incident. I, P.O. MOORE, forwarded a Video Retrieval form to Squad 1927, Forensic Investigator, Sarah RAKOWSKI, for retrieval of the video.

Squad 7322, P.O. Daniel STUPAR, responded to this incident then subsequently summarily arrested George BANKHEAD for Criminal Damage to Property. Further investigation revealed that BANKHEAD also violated the terms of his Probation. BANKHEAD was conveyed to District 7 for processing. This incident was assigned case# 15-276-0017.

Quiana MILTON's decisiveness and cooperation in this investigation were pivotal components in solving this crime. MILTON was voluntarily forthcoming with pertinent information that assisted Officers during our investigatory stage.

This report is written by P.O. Joseph SPINGOLA JR., assigned to District Four, Early Shift.

On Friday, 03-20-15, at approximately 9:30pm, Squad 4281 (P.O. James KLUSMANN and I), along with Squad 4283 (P.O. Richard FREDERICKS and P.O. Matthew RITTNER), were asked to assist the Wisconsin Department of Revenue – Alcohol and Tobacco Enforcement with several establishment/premise checks.

During this time period from 2pm-10pm, numerous establishments were visited, where business documents, alcoholic beverages, and tobacco products were inspected and verified.

Our fifth and final visit of the night, was at the establishment Dee's Elegance, located at 7420 W. Villard Avenue, which is subsequently located within the City and County of Milwaukee. During this business contact, we identified the bar tender as Kimberly J. PETERSIK (b/f, 05-09-74). PETERSIK was fully cooperative with our investigation, providing us full access to business records and documents, where a verbal warning was given to PETERSIK to have invoices and other paperwork properly organized for proper on sight viewing in the future. During this inspection, numerous bottles of alcohol were located and seized after being informed that they were gifts from customers, personal bottles for after parties, or bottles not tracked by invoices. PETERSIK was then given additional warning against the diluting or re-filling of alcohol bottles, further informing her of possible consequences to licensure and permit approval upon the renewal period.

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

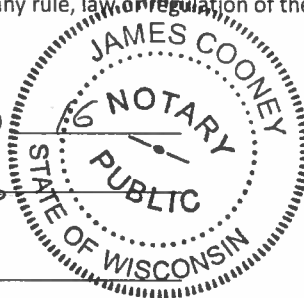
