If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

- 7. On 12/13/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 2537 West National Avenue. No violations were observed.
- 8. On 01/31/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a loud music complaint at 2537 West National Avenue (Candelas). Officers could hear music while standing outside at the rear of the business. They spoke to the applicant who indicated he would ask the DJ to turn down the base on the speakers and he would look into having the rear of the building sound proofed. No violations were observed and no citations were issued.

9. On 11/25/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 2537 West National Avenue. No violations were observed.

10.On 12/26/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shots fired complaint at 2537 West National Avenue (Candela's Bar). Milwaukee police incident report #153600005 was filed regarding a casing recovered outside the premise. Upon arrival, officers discovered the front door to the business was locked and they had to knock to gain entry. Once inside, officers discovered several patrons under the legal drinking age of 21 and that the number of patrons exceeded the posted authorized occupancy of 99. Officers counted 290 patrons as they exited the business. The applicant, who was on the scene during this incident, received several citations.

PA-33E Narrative

This report was typed by PO Salvador HERNANDEZ, assigned to D2, Late Power Shift. On Saturday, December 26, 2015 at 12:22am while on Squad 2464 with PO KAZACHENKO we responded to 2537 W. National Ave, regarding a shots fired complaint along with multiple other squads. All squads on scene were Squad 951 PO BORCHERT/ PO FEDERER, Squad 762 PO WILKINSON/PO KOWALIK, Squad 2340 PO BOEHN/PO RATKOWSKI, Squad 2350 PO PICENO/PO SPINATO, Squad 2472 PO JACKSON/PO JUSTUS, Squad 757 PO BURGER, Squad 761 PO MURRAY/PO RITTNER, Squad 2390 PO SPINATO, and Squad 2412 Sgt. PANNING. A total of 10 squads responded and assisted with this investigation.

The address of 2537 W. National Ave. is a licensed premise by the name of Candela's Bar. The licensee who was on the premises is Martin JIMENEZ-SEGURA w/m 09-17-79. Upon arrival, I observed many police vehicles and a large crowd outside the premises. The front door to the premises was locked and I had to knock in order to be let inside. While inside, I spoke to JIMENEZ-SEGURA who was behind the bar. I expressed to JIMENEZ-SEGURA that there appeared to be many patrons under 21 years of age. JIMENEZ-SEGURA stated there were patrons inside the establishment that were not 21 years of age but were not drinking and were not allowed by the bar. JIMENEZ-SEGURA confirmed to me that he had patrons less than 21 years of age and patrons 21 and over having a "pajama" party at his establishment. JIMENEZ-SEGURA could not assure me that the underage patrons were not drinking alcoholic beverages. I was unable to get any names of the minors due to the large amount of patrons on the premise. JIMENEZ-SEGURA was also unable to provide proof of a special permit for this event. JIMENEZ-SEGURA became bothered after I advised him that the patrons leaving his establishment were causing a disturbance, disturbing the peace outside. I advised JIMENEZ-SEGURA that police was called because shots were fired outside of his establishment by possibly patrons leaving.

JIMENEZ-SEGURA stated we were harassing him and that we should pay attention to the bars selling drugs and not his. I explained to JIMENEZ-SEGURA that I personally have responded to his establishment multiple times due to the patrons leaving his premise fighting, being loud, cruising, and discharging weapons disturbing the peace and creating a disturbance. JIMENEZ-SEGURA stated he was renting the hall to a second party and they were in charge of the party not him. I explained to JIMENEZ-SEGURA that he was the licensee and he was ultimately responsible for what occurred inside and immediately outside his door in regards to his patrons.

The maximum authorized occupancy posted was 99 patrons. JIMENEZ-SEGURA decided to end the "pajama" party while officers were on scene and asked security to start escorting patrons out. I stood with my body camera on, near the exit and began to count the number of patrons exiting. I counted 290 patrons exiting the premise excluding the patrons that were escorted out before police arrival and employees on scene. For purposes of determining the amount for this violation the court may treat each person found to have been on the premises in excess of the permitted limit as a separate violation, but not to exceed \$25,000. This violation could have had an amount of \$59,783 for 191 patrons over the posted limit but it exceeds the maximum per city ordinance. I advised JIMENEZ-SEGURA that I would be citing him for multiple violations I had observed in the establishment.

Squad 2472 PO JUSTUS/PO JACKSON located a casing outside the premise on the southwest corner of the building on the sidewalk. A separate report was filed under incident #15-360-0005. I checked the call history going back to July of 2015 and found multiple calls as follows:

07-27-15 The call was for a battery complaint, patrons fighting.

07-31-15 The call was for a battery complaint, patrons fighting.

08-14-15 The call was for a loud music complaint regarding the premise.

08-14-15 The call was for trouble with a subject, patrons fighting.

10-03-15 the call was for a loud music complaint regarding the premise.

JIMENEZ-SEGURA was cited for allowing underage on premises, not allowing immediate entry to police during an investigation, exceeding occupy limit by 191 patrons, and disorderly premise.

If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This is to inform you that I do not support the new application for a license at 3530 W. National Avenue.

We had no problems when the owner of the building ran the bar, but anytime there has been a renter running it we have had problems with loud noise, littering and loitering. Much of what the applicant had on her application was what the last owners had. were unable to sleep as long as the business was open because of the loud music (base), and people loitering while they were out

smoking, not only on the side of the property, 36th Street, but the whole front of the building including my building on National Avenue. Cigarette butts never got cleaned up. They piled up on the sidewalk and gutter. Because there is a sewer grate right along side of the sidewalk, many made its way right down the sewer. The front and side streets was full of garbage continuously. Complaints went on deaf ear. Of yes, a flower pot was finally put outside with flowers in it for people to put butts in. No one seemed to know what it was for so they just got thrown down on the ground

anyway. There is a back door and a parking lot that they easily could go to and smoke. I don't know where they would plan on having live music as the place is not that big. There are two pool tables in the place and some round tables for people to sit at besides the bar which may seat 25-30, and that would be crowding it.

This applicant has not made any effort to talk to any of us in the neighborhood. The owner told me that he advised her that she should try and come talk to me because of all my concerns after the last people were there and were not very cooperative with regards to the noise and my tenants. There has been no contact what so ever,

These are some of the reasons why I don't support this.
