

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

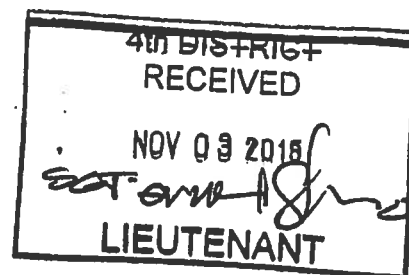

The incident occurred when at approximately 7:45 pm on the listed date, Myrtle M MOSS (b/f, 03/04/1962) entered the above location through the main entry door, located on the north east side of the building, and demanded to be served at the bar. Jeffrey A GARMS (w/m, 07/14/1956), the licensed owner of the tavern was behind the bar and refused to serve MOSS due to her level of intoxication. MOSS told GARMS a police would need to be called to get her out of the tavern. GARMS took action by grabbing MOSS by her arm in attempt to escort her off the premises. MOSS then pulled out a hand gun. GARMS explained that he held her right arm, and she fired what he believed to be two rounds. GARMS and MOSS struggled and both fell to the ground as he managed to get the hand gun out of MOSS' hand. GARMS then noticed he was shot in his upper left bicep. Medical responded to the location to treat GARMS, whose injuries were non life threatening. MOSS was arrested on scene.

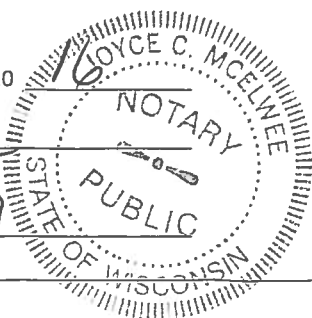
