This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 05/07/10 at 6:45 pm, Milwaukee police were conducting underage sales of alcohol and had a police aide, who is under the age of 21, enter 4770 N Hopkins in attempts to purchase alcohol. The clerk, identified as Galina Esphteyn, sold a six pack of Corona Extra without asking for any ID. Galina admitted to selling the beer and cited for sale to underage.

2. On 09/20/2014 a 16 year old, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, was able to purchase two Good Times flavor wraps from the cashier, Daljinder Singh, at 4770 North Hopkins Street (Choice Liquor). An officer also observed Singh selling alcohol to a customer even though he does not possess a valid class D operator's license and was the only employee present. The applicant received two citations.

3. On 11/12/2015 Milwaukee police, along with agents from the Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at 4770 North Hopkins Street (Choice Liquor). During this check, a subject entered the store carrying a box containing various tobacco products. This subject stated that she had purchased the tobacco products at Food Town/Universal for Virender Singh. Singh, who is listed on the application as 50% shareholder, admitted he had the subject pick up the tobacco products illegally. Agent King confiscated the tobacco and explained that the business cannot purchase tobacco without an invoice.

This report was written by P.O. Dean DRAJKOWSKI assigned to the License Unit day shift. On Thursday, November 12, 2015, at about 11:15 AM, while assigned to Squad 2741, along with Agents Georgeann KING and Erin DORN from the Department of Revenue, we conducted a licensed premise inspection at Choice Liquor located at 4770 N. Hopkins St.

Upon arrival, we spoke with the co-owner, Virender SINGH, A/M, 12-22-64, of 870 Taft Ter., Hartford, WI. Agent KING explained the inspection to SINGH. During the inspection, I observed a black female enter the liquor store holding a box with tobacco. The female observed the Police and immediatley exited the store. I pursued after the female and had her return to the store. She was identified as Dorcille D. WILLINGHAM, B/F, 08-12-84, of 3525 W. Hampton Ave. WILLINGHAM had a box containing various uninvoiced tobacco products. WILLINGHAM stated she got the tobacco from Food Town/Universal for SINGH. Agent KING spoke with SINGH regarding the uninvoiced tobacco. SINGH admitted he had WILLINGHAM pick up the tobacco illegally. Agent KING confiscated the various tobacco products. Agent KING explained to SINGH that the business can not purchase tobacco without a proper invoice. The agent for the business was Jagjit S. CHEEMA, A/M, 11-16-60. CHEEMA was at his other liquor store, Sunshine Liquor located at 3541 W. Villard Ave. The licenses were posted in the business.





GOGGANS interviewed the caller who verbally identified herself as Angel S PATTERSON (F/B, 10-01-76). Angel stated she was sitting at the bar inside of Waz's (4532 W. Burleigh St) with a friend of hers. Angel stated her sister, who she identified as Ayanna M PATTERSON (F/B, 03-18-79), came into the bar and began a verbal argument with her because Angel didn't go see Ayanna when she was in the hospital. Ayanna then pulled Angel's hair. Angel stated someone at the bar broke up the fight and asked them to leave. This concludes the interview of Angel.

I interviewed the bartender, who was identified by WI ID as Janita M REED (F/B,01-11-68 of 131 E. Chambers). REED stated she was bartending when she observed a verbal argument between two female patrons. REED observed one of the patrons grab the other one's hair and the two began physically fighting. REED broke the fight up and told the patrons they could no longer be at the bar. REED told one of the patrons to leave and the other to wait a few minutes before she left so that a fight wouldn't occur outside.

REED was cooperative with our investigation.

I attempted to notify David T. WASMUND of this incident on 08/03/15 at 8:00pm but did not receive an answer and the voicemail box was not operating.
