This is in response to your request on behalf of the businesses at 2612 South Greeley Street to restrict on-street parking to allow trucks to maneuver to their loading area.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that trucks do have a difficult time maneuvering to and from their loading docks due to the narrowness of the local roadways. The installation of this restriction will make it easier to access the loading docks. Therefore, we recommend the installation of the above-captioned parking restriction.
