Assisting in this assignment was Najila N. HINTON B/F 12/06/97, 2831 N. 45th St., MIlwaukee, WI 53210. HINTON is 17 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco. A photo of HINTON was taken at the beginning of the assignment for identification.

At approximately 11:55A, HINTON entered Grocery King, located at 2500 W. Lisbon Ave., and purchased a 3 pack jackpot Pineapple Flavored Cigars. HINTON provided a description of the cashier that sold her the tobacco. I entered the store and spoke with the cashier that matched the description. The subject was identified as Ala i Issa A/M 04/02/97. ISSA admitted to the sale and stated he thought HINTON looked old enough to purchase tobacco. ISSA was advised an enrollment letter for the M.A.R.T.S. program would be mailed to the agent.


