



ORDER Case No. 16CV004532

This case came before the court yesterday for the court's decision on the petitioner's motion for a temporary injunction.

For the reasons stated on the record at today's hearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The petitioner's motion for a temporary injunction is denied.
- 2. The temporary restraining order issued by the court on June 14, 2016 and continued on June 16, 2016 is vacated.
- 3. The order contained in paragraph 2 takes effect at 5:00 p.m. on July 7, 2016.
- 4. The petitioner's request for a stay pending appeal is denied.
- 5. The City promptly shall disclose to the petitioner police reports authored by witnesses who testified before the Licenses Committee of the Milwaukee Common Council on May 31, 2016 relating to the incident at Texas Jay's on April 2, 2016, the investigation of the incident and the execution of a search warrant issued for certain portions of the premises on April 3, 2016.
- 6. On or before July 29, 2016, the City shall file the record of the proceedings before the Licenses Committee and before the Common Council.

- 7. The court will conduct a scheduling conference on August 11, 2016 at 8:45 a.m.
- 8. As of August 1, 2016, as a result of regular calendar rotation, this case is assigned to Branch 3, the Hon. Clare Fiorenza. Proceedings will be heard in Room 500, Courthouse.
