There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 12-26-05, Milwaukee Police were called to Mary's Rainbow Inn at 2911 W. North Ave for several subjects fighting inside the bar. As officers were responding, the call was upgraded to shots fired. Investigation revealed bar patrons were fighting inside the bar and were escorted out by security. It was shortly after when several shots were heard in front of the bar. No one was injured, however, damage was caused to two parked cars in front of the bar from the bullets that were fired. A report was filed.
- 2. On 12-31-05, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Mary's Rainbow Inn at 2911 W North Ave for a shots fired call. Investigation revealed an unknown male entered the tavern and fired one shot from a shotgun into the ceiling for unknown reasons. This unknown male then fled the scene. No one was injured and a 12GA shell was recovered from the scene. A report was filed.
- 3. On 01-25-06 at 2:15am, a license premise check was conducted when officers noticed that Mary's Rainbow Inn was open passed the allowed time of 2:00am. Officers spoke to the victim who stated she was a patron at Mary's Rainbow Inn and as she left the tavern around 8:54 pm, she was approached by a male who displayed a gun and demanded her money. When she refused, he struck the victim on her head with gun several times and took ten dollars from her hand. Subject then fled the scene. A report was filed.

Police spoke with the victim who stated that around 10 pm he was inside the Rainbow Inn having a beer and that around 10:20 pm, he exited the bar to smoke a cigarette. The victim stated that a subject came from his right side and tackled him to the ground, punching and striking the victim in the head. The subject then stated, "Give me your wallet" and removed it from the victim's back right pocket. The subject then fled the scene. The bar did have surveillance cameras however they do not record. A report was filed.
- 15. On 01/24/11 at 10:49 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2911 W North Avenue for an Armed Robbery complaint. Police spoke with the victim who stated he was robbed as he was about to enter the bar Rainbow. The victim further stated that he was not allowed in the bar and went home to call for police. Officers spoke with MC Cole who works for the bar, but was upstairs in the residence part of the building when the incident occurred. Cole stated he received a call from his bartender stating someone was being robbed in front of the business. Cole stated he went to look outside and was approached by a subject who was armed with a black semi-automatic and attempted to rob Cole. The suspect obtained nothing because a patron was exiting the tavern and the suspect got distracted and fled through a gangway. Cole further stated it was shortly thereafter when he heard two gunshots. Police also spoke with the bartender Timothy Fitch, who stated that a male subject came to the door and yelled. "I just got robbed" and told his security not to open the door and called MC Cole to see if he could see anything. Fitch stated he then called police. On Monday, 01/24/11 at 12:04 am, Milwaukee police responded to St Joseph's Hospital for a Shooting complaint. Police spoke with the victim who stated he was driving eastbound on North Avenue from 29th Street to go to the bar "Rainbow" when he heard several gunshots. The victim stated he then felt pain in his left hand and realized he was shot. The victim received three stitches to his third finger. Police spoke with the licensee Keith Winters regarding these incidents and advised him a report was going to be filed.





NARRATIVE SECTION: This report is written by P.O. Ashley VAN DRISSE, assigned to District 3, early power shift. On Thursday, September 30th, 2015, an undercover operation was conducted regarding the illegal sale of single cigarettes at various "convenience store" type establishments in or near the Washington Park Neighborhood. During said operation, officers conducted a licensed premise check at 1606 N. 35th St., "ABC Liquor and Beer Depot III", regarding the above mentioned violation. This establishment does hold a valid Class "A" Malt & Liquor license/Cigarette and Tobacco license through the City of Milwaukee. Undercover police employees did enter this location on three separate occasions and were able to purchase single cigarettes each time. Each violation is as follows:

At approximately 12:01PM, P.O. Melvin FINKLEY, who was operating in an undercover capacity (plain clothes) did enter the listed licensed premise and was able to purchase four single cigarettes, "Newport" brand, from the employee behind the register. P.O. FINKLEY stated that the employee charged him \$2.00 in U.S. currency for said cigarettes, which the employee produced from the right pocket of his pants. P.O. FINKLEY also purchased a bag of white cheddar popcorn for \$0.50 cents. Using three predetermined dollar bills (Serial #'s F63024112H, G73088810D and K87987133E) P.O. FINKLEY gave said dollars to the employee in exchange for the cigarettes and popcorn. P.O. FINKLEY did receive \$0.50 in change from the employee. P.O. FINKLEY described the employee that sold him the single cigarettes as a Middle Eastern male, 20's, 502-504, thin build, wearing a red T-shirt, standing behind the register.

At approximately 12:40PM, P.O. Thomas MARCUS, who was operating in an undercover capacity (plain clothes) did enter the listed licensed premise and was able to purchase five single cigarettes, "Newport" brand, from the employee behind the register. P.O. MARCUS stated that the employee charged him \$2.00 in U.S. currency for said cigarettes, which the employee produced from the right pocket of his pants. P.O. MARCUS also purchased a bag of Chester's Flamin' Hot Fries for \$0.50 cents. Using three predetermined dollar bills (Serial #'s F40470530D, C81260861A, J00503646*) P.O. MARCUS gave said dollars to the employee in exchange for the cigarettes and fries. P.O. MARCUS did receive \$0.50 in change from the employee. P.O. FINKLEY described the employee that sold him the single cigarettes as a Middle Eastern male, early 20's, 502-504, thin build, wearing a gray hooded zip-up sweatshirt with an orange T-shirt underneath, standing behind the register.

At approximately 12:50PM, P.A. Herbert L. DAVIS III, who was operating in an undercover capacity (plain clothes) did enter the listed licensed premise and was able to purchase three single cigarettes, "Newport" brand, from the employee behind the register. P.A. DAVIS stated that the employee charged him \$1.50 in U.S. currency for said cigarettes, which the employee produced from a shelve just to right of where he was standing. P.A. DAVIS also purchased a bag of cool ranch flavored crunchy nuggets for \$0.50 cents. Using two predetermined dollar bills (Serial #'s D14917259E and G46770178D) P.A. DAVIS gave said dollars to the employee in exchange for the cigarettes and snack. P.A. LEWIS did receive \$0.50 in change from the employee. P.A. DAVIS described the employee that sold him the single cigarettes as the same employee that sold to P.O. MARCUS.

At approximately 1:00PM, P.O. Thomas GUTHRIE, P.O. Stephen OSMANSKI, P.O. LESNIEWSKI, Sgt.Teresa JANICK, Agent's Georgeann KING and Rick UHLIG from the Department of Revenue and myself entered the establishment and located the above-described subject standing behind the register in an enclosed area. Upon speaking with this subject, he identified himself as Najmal NMI MOHAMED-DHAWHEED, M/A, 09-08-93, of 2947 S. 11th St., ph# 337-541-9446. When asked if he was selling single cigarettes from the premises, MOHAMED-DHAWHEED, admitted that he had but that it was not common practice. MOHAMED-DHAWHEED then called the licensee, Kamal P. SINGH to come to the location. Agent UHLIG did note that when they walked into the location he saw MOHAMED-DHAWHEED try to conceal the open pack of cigarettes by pushing them further underneath the counter where he was standing. I then observed an opened pack of "Newport" brand cigarettes with cigarettes missing on the counter, which Agent UHLIG stated he recovered from where he observed MOHAMED-DHAWHEED attempt to conceal them. At this time, MOHAMED-DHAWHEED was advised that he would be cited regarding this offense. Also, P.O. OSMANSKI was to recover three of the eight predetermined dollar bills from the register.

Shortly after, the licensee, Kamal P. SINGH arrived onscene at which time I informed him of our operation and what took place at his establishment. I also notified SINGH that a licensed premise report would be generated as well as a nuisance letter from the Milwaukee Police Department regarding the three sales of single cigarettes that occurred at his establishment on this date.

Also while at this location, Agents KING and UHLIG did confiscate several boxes of liquor due to them being illegally transferred from another licensed premises. See attached field report provided by the agents.

Once the field portion of this operation concluded, P.O. Thomas GUTHRIE placed the purchased single cigarettes on MPD Inventory AC# 15035015 at District #3.


