



This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 11-7-04, at 11:20PM, officers conducted a premises check at Primo's Place, 1631 W Grant Street. Upon arrival they observed the back and only exit door of the tavern locked during hours of operation. Also, no occupancy placard was posted, as required. Officer spoke to the bartender who told officers he was in charge while his brother the licensee, was in Mexico for the holidays.

Bartender, Jose L Terrones-Valdivia was issued the following

- 2. On 07-23-06, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2492 S 13th Street for a Trouble with Subject call. The complaint stated that subjects in the tavern were using drugs. Investigation revealed two patrons in the bar with one subject possessing cocaine. This subject was arrested and charged with POCS-Cocaine and the other patron was arrested on an outstanding warrant. Officers did speak with the licensee, Jose Terrones, who stated he was unaware that drugs were being used in his tavern. No other violations were found.
- 3. On 08-07-06, Milwaukee Police conducted a tavern check at 2492 S 13th Street, El Azteca Bar. Officers observed a patron in the rear of the bar with a dollar bill containing a white powdery substance that the patron was inhaling. Once he saw officers, the subject dropped the dollar bill and tried to leave the area. Officers conducted a field interview and recovered the dollar bill with white powder residue on it. This subject was arrested and charged with POCS-Cocaine. Officers spoke to the licensee Jose Terrones, who was on scene, regarding the drug use in the tavern. No other violations were found.
- 4. On 06/10/07 at 1:55 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2492 S 13th Street for Subject With Gun complaint. Investigation revealed a bar patron became disorderly and was provoking other patrons into fighting him. The bartender, identified as Jessica Villarreal, served the patron a bottle of beer when this patron placed in his pocket. Villarreal stated this patron was asked to leave and as he was walking out of the tavern, continued to provoke other patrons. Once outside, other patrons followed and a fight started. Villarreal and the licensee, Jose Terrones, went to break up the fight when Villarreal observed the disorderly patron walked to his car, retrieve a gun and place it in his waistband. Villarreal stated she grabbed the gun and threw it into the back seat of the auto and told the patron to leave the area. The subject left but threatened to come back and shoot up the bar.
- 5. On 01/12/08 at 12:14 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 13th and Arthur Avenue for a Fight complaint with officers advised that the fight started at the Azteca bar. Police arrived and did not observe anyone fighting in the area. Officers entered the tavern and spoke to Jose Terrones who stated there was an argument inside the tavern between two patrons and they were asked to leave. Terrones stated he didn't know the patrons nor what the argument was about.

6. On 01/17/08 at 7:30 pm, Milwaukee police along with an agent from Department of Revenue Alcohol & Tobacco Enforcement conducted a tavern check at 2492 S 13th Street. Officers spoke with the bartender Ismael Gonzalez who was able to show officers his valid bartenders license. When asked to view the beverages invoices, Gonzalez stated he did not know where they were and called the licensee Jose Terrones. Terrones arrived on scene shortly after and when asked to view the beverage invoices, Terrones admitted to purchasing his liquor from Oklahoma Liquor since he has owned the bar. (Which is about 3 years) Officers advised Terrones that under Wisconsin law, he is required to purchase liquor from an authorized distributor and maintain the invoices for two years at the licensed premise. A total of 31 various liquor bottles were seized. A warning was given to Terrones regarding the violations.

- 7. On 03/27/08 at 3:27 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2492 S 13th Street for an Entry complaint. Officers spoke to Jose Terrones who stated he arrived at his business at 1:30 pm to find the cash register missing along with a commercial DVD machine broken into. Terrones stated he left the tavern approximately at 2:00 am the night before and remembers locking the door. There were no security cameras or an alarm system on the business. Officers found the entry was gained through a window and a report was filed.
- 8. On 10/18/08 at 12:24 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Battery at 2492 S 13th Street. Upon arrival, officers spoke to the victim who stated while he was in the bathroom of El Azteca bar he was approached by 3-4 males who began pulling on the victims' clothes, ripping his shirt. The victim stated he left the tavern and did not want to make a complaint since he couldn't identify the suspects. During the investigation, a patron inside the tavern became loud and belligerent and began swearing at officers. The subject was overheard telling others in the tavern not to talk to police about what happened or they would "be sorry" and that he would "take care of them". Officers arrested this subject and issued him citations for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing An Officer.
- 9. On 01/09/09 at 6:45 pm, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise check at 2492 S 13th Street. Officers spoke to the bartender Aida Santiago who provided her bartenders license along with the taverns liquor license. The licensee, Jose Terrones, was on scene and when asked for receipts and invoices for the liquor that was purchased for the tavern, Terrones stated he did not have them on the premise. Officers advised Terrones this was a violation and confiscated the liquor and provided Terrones a receipt. Officers further advised Terrones that they would be notifying an agent with the State Department of Revenue regarding this incident. Officers also observed a door to the north side of the establishment that was locked with a deadbolt and fortified with a 2X4 piece of lumber. Officers were checking with a building inspector to see if this was a violation.

_______ 10. On 06/24/12 at 9:46 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2492 S 13th Street for a Subject With Gun complaint. Investigation revealed a patron, who was inside the bar prior to the incident, was found to be in possession of a pellet gun when police observed him standing outside of the business. The subject was arrested and cited for multiple violations. Officers spoke to the bartender on scene, Jessica Villarreal, and no violations were observed. ______


- 11. On 08/12/2013 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at 1209 West Arthur Street. En route, officers were advised that a shooting had occurred at 2492 South 13th Street (El Azteca). Investigation revealed the applicant had been shot in the hand and abdomen. The applicant stated he had removed a female patron earlier in the night. The same female returned with an unknown male subject who committed the shooting. - 12. On 09/03/2013 Milwaukee police met with the applicant at Milwaukee police district #2. This meeting was held as a result of the shooting that had occurred at the business on 08/12/2013. During this meeting, police advised the applicant of the requirement of cameras after 3 criminal activities take place. Additionally, information was exchanged between the police and the applicant regarding the prior shooting.
- 13. On 12/14/2013 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at 2492 South 13th Street. Investigation revealed an unknown actor(s) had fired a shot from outside the business

which had penetrated the exterior wall of the business. Milwaukee police incident report #133480008 filed.
