Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/03/2013 the applicant met with Captain Victor Beecher, Lieutenant Joseph Seitz and Lieutenant Shannon M. Seymer-Tabaska of the Milwaukee police department at the applicant's request. Also in attendance were Obiora Obi, described during the meeting as 75% owner and General Manager, and Sheena Tally, described during the meeting as manager. The applicant was described during the meeting as a 0% owner. During this meeting, some of the potential problems related to a business holding a Class B Tavern license in general and the applicant's ability to handle those potential problems was discussed. The applicant told police he wanted to work collaboratively and cooperatively with police and believed many of the problems that may occur at the business could be handled by security. The applicant informed police that he would be responsible for executive decisions and administration of the business.

2. On 08/04/2014 the applicant, along with Obiora Obi and a representative from Lucas security. met with Captain Beecher and Sergeant Donovan-Agnew of the Milwaukee police department at Milwaukee police district #4 regarding the re-opening of Onyx. Several changes were outlined by the applicant and Obi that they hoped would help them better operate the establishment. The applicant and Obi stated they are looking forward to working with the department and operating a successful business.

3. On 08/15/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at Onyx Night Club. Obiora Obi identified himself as the Manager/Owner of the property and told officers he has hired a new security contractor, that the business will not allow anyone under the age of 25 into the club and that the business will close at 1:30am or 1:45am depending on the size of the crowd. Obi requested Milwaukee police squads be in the area at closing time.

- 4. On 04/25/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a theft complaint that occurred at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). Investigation revealed two patrons of the business placed their wallets on a table while they had their pictures taken in a booth. When they went to retrieve their wallets, they discovered both were gone. Obiora Obi and bar security were very cooperative with police during this investigation which led to the suspect being identified and cited.
- 5. On 05/29/2015 Milwaukee police conducted follow up at Onyx Night Club (3120 West Villard Avenue) regarding an arson investigation. Obiora Obi told officers he received a phone call from a Milwaukee police officer around 5:00am 05/28/2015 advising him of an attempt arson at his business. Obi viewed video footage of the incident and discovered an unknown person pouring gasoline around the exterior of the building, then lighting it with a match or lighter. Milwaukee police incident report #151480019 filed.
- 6. On 06/02/2015 the applicant, as well as Obiora Obi, met with Milwaukee police at Milwaukee police district #4 regarding an event planned for Onyx Night Club on 06/22/2015. The business will be hosting an event on that date featuring "Lil Wayne". A discussion was held regarding a plan for the staging of this event. Mr. Obi stated he would provide the police with a written copy of the plan.
- 7. On 06/27/2015 Milwaukee police, along with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). During this inspection, officers observed no violations of municipal ordinance. However, agents discovered 37 contaminated bottles that were disposed of at the location.

- 8. On 09/01/2015 Obi Obiora and Richard Lucas attended a scheduled meeting at Milwaukee police district #4 regarding upcoming events at Onyx. During this meeting, Mr. Obiora stated he had 3 upcoming events and requested additional police presence on 09/19/2015 for an event where he anticipated approximately 500 attendees.
- 9. On 12/27/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at Onyx Night Club. Security told officers there had been a fight inside the club, but there were no injuries. All involved parties were gone when officers arrived.
- 10. On 01/01/2016 at 4:28am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shooting at Onyx Night Club, while other officers were dispatched to St. Joes Hospital to meet with the victim. Officers spoke to Obi Obiora who was identified as the manager and told officers he was not aware of a shooting at his location. Mr. Obiora allowed officers to view video captured by his security camera system. This video depicted at 3:29am, two individuals engaged in a verbal altercation outside of the main enterance with several other individuals attempting to intervene. At no time did the officers observe a gun or any one being physically assaulted. A security guard was interviewed and stated he heard shots fired but believed they were from distance. The victim of

this offense told officers he heard gunshots as he was crossing West Villard Avenue southbound from the Onyx Night Club, when he heard gunshots and realized he had been shot in the leg. Milwaukee police incident report #160010048 filed.

- 11. On 01/31/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight/battery at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). The victim stated he was physically assaulted in a bathroom stall at the business and robbed of \$2,000. Milwaukee police incident report #160310019 filed. During this investigation, officers heard two gunshots and observed patrons fleeing the business. Officers entered the business and located a victim who sustained a gunshot wound to his leg. A security guard stated prior to the shooting an individual involved in an argument was escorted out of the building. Approximately 10- 15 minutes later the bar lights were turned on and he observed the same subject inside the bar fighting with others. He did not see a firearm, but heard two gunshots. Milwaukee police incident report #160310017 filed.
- 12. On 02/06/2016 a meeting was held at Milwaukee police district #4 regarding a shooting that had occurred on 01/31/2016. It was pointed out that no major incidents had occurred at Onyx since it reopened until the shooting. Obiora Obi stated the victim of the robbery (see item #11) had been flashing money all night prior to being robbed in the men's room. He further stated the promoter of this event promoted to known gang members, which was unknown to him or his security staff until the group showed up. He admitted they had become lax in searching people and he was considering changing the business's age limit. Obi stated he would send a new security plan and continue to work with district #4.
- 13. On 02/13/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a subject with a gun complaint at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). While en-route, officers were advised that the firearm was in a black Honda bearing Wisconsin registration. Officers observed the described vehicle and discovered a handgun in plain view partially under the passenger side front seat. Investigation revealed the owner of the auto, Devin Cooper, had become belligerent while inside the business and was removed by security. Once outside the business, Cooper retrieved a handgun, which he place in the waistband of his pants, from the auto. Security for the club began dialogue with Cooper and eventually he threw the firearm back into the car. Cooper was detained by security until police arrived. Cooper was arrested. Milwaukee police incident report #160440016 filed.
- 14. On 02/27/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). Security stated there had been a fight inside the business. Security separated the individuals involved and forced them to leave the club. One of the involved parties fired three shots outside of the establishment shortly after being forced to leave. This subject was apprehended by security after a chase and detained for police. Security also discovered a handgun on the ground after checking the area. Video shows security breaking up a fight inside the club and removing the subjects. It then shows the suspect attempting to re-enter the club and being refused entry. The video then shows one of the subjects initially involved in the fight leaving the club. The suspect is then observed chasing this individual and firing three shots at the individual. Milwaukee police incident report #160580014 filed.
- 15. On 03/06/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). Security personnel told officers there had been a fight inside the club. The involved parties were escorted out and one of the subjects yelled for someone to get the gun from inside the vehicle. Fearing the situations would escalate, security called 911. The parties involved were gone when officers arrived.

- 16. On 04/24/2016 Milwaukee police were in the area of North 32nd Street and West Villard Avenue when they hear a gunshot. The sound appeared to come from the parking lot southwest of Onyx. Upon arrival officers observed 30-40 individuals in the parking lot with security from Onyx trying to disburse the crowd. Officers observed a subject, Tashauna Brewster, with blood on her mouth and her dress standing in front of a car in the parking lot. Brewster told officers she had left the club and had beeped her horn at a group of females standing in front of her car preventing her from leaving the parking lot. The females began punching her through the window. Brewster was dragged from her car by the females who continued to punch her. An unknown female fired one shot in the air and then entered a vehicle and fled the scene. Brewster was transported to St. Mary's hospital where she received stitches to her lower lip. Milwaukee police incident report #161150024 filed.
- 17. On 05/08/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shooting at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). Investigation revealed no one had been shot, but several shots had been fired in the parking lot utilized by customers of the business. There had been a fight inside the business that continued outside. During this fight the victim was knocked unconscious and received several stiches. While the fight was happening, two individuals fired 14 shots in the parking lot. Three firearms, including a stolen handgun and an AK47 style assault rifle, along with 17 grams of cocaine based powder and 3 grams of marijuana were recovered. Five arrests were made. Milwaukee police incident reports #161290025, #162390027, #161290028 and #161290064 were filed.
- 18.On 05/13/2016 Milwaukee police, along with representatives from the City Attorney's office and the District Attorney's office met with representatives from Onyx Social Club. Assistant City Attorney Nick Desiato recommended the age limit be raised to 23 and changes needed to be made to the interior security personnel. The applicant was given a Nuisance letter and asked what they were willing to do to change. The applicant stated they will come up with a plan continue to work with police.
- 19. On 05/15/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a trouble with a subject complaint at 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). Security for the club told officers that there had been a fight inside the business. When the involved parties were being escorted out, one of them stated he was going to get a gun and come back. No weapons were observed and the involved parties were gone when police arrived.
- 20. On 05/21/2016 Milwaukee police were instructed to monitor 3120 West Villard Avenue (Onyx Night Club). At approximately 1:50am, security from the business forced multiple subjects out of the tavern that had been involved in a fight. While clearing the fight, officers heard two shots. It was later determined that an officer had fired at an auto that had struck an officer. The establishment provided security video footage on the incident. Milwaukee police incident report #161420017 filed.

On 09/01/15 at 5pm, Mr Obi Obiora along with Richard Lucas (Security) came into District Four, for a scheduled meeting to discuss up coming events at the Onyx.

Mr. Obiora stated he was having three up coming events. The first on was on 09/04/15, the second was on 09/11/15 and stated he was going to have 15 unarmed security officers on the interior of the business and four armed officers for the exterior. He stated these were not going to be large events but was expecting 300 to 400 people. He requested Police officers to assist with traffic at closing time. Mr. Oboria stated the big event will be on 09/19/15. Tony Neil will be the DJ and LIL' BOOZIE will be performing at midnight.

Mr. Oboria is requesting full capicity from The City of Milwaukee, which is 675. He is expecting approximatley 500 people to attend. He stated he will have 25 unarmed security officers on the interior and 8 armed officers on the exterior. They will have parking available in the CVS parking lot, and Food Town parking lot after 9pm. He is charging \$30.00 per person. The will be wanding and conducting a pat down search of all persons who enter the building. Mr. Oboria is requesting extra patrol after 10pm and at closing time

On Saturday, December 27th, 2015, at 12:58 am, I, along with my partner, P.O. Martinez MOORE (PS# 015951), while assigned to Squad 4375, were dispatched to 3120 W. Villard Ave, the Onyx Night Club, for a Fight in progress. Squads 4390, P.O. Dennis B. McKNIGHT (PS# 025698) and 4312 Sgt Jeffrey D. DOLKIEWICZ (PS# 014100) were also on scene.

Upon arrival, P.O. MOORE spoke with security for the club, Derek A. WEILER, w/m, 08-01-79, 840 N. Old World Third St, 414-807-2450, who stated he heard over his hand held radio that several females were engaged in a fight inside of the club. WEILER stated that a few minutes later, he observed several females exit the front entrance of the club. He stated these subjects were grabbing and throwing punches at each other. WEILER stated that he and other security personnel immediately intervened and the female subjects quickly dispersed. No basic information was obtained by club security regarding the identity of the disorderly subjects, and according to club security no one was injured as a result of this incident. All subjects involved were no longer on scene upon officers arrival.

Security personnel and club management were forthcoming with information and there were no other incidents on this night at the venue.

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This Report of Incidents Involving Licensed Persons or Premises, tavern report, was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS# 015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Friday, January 1, 2016, at 4:28 A.M., Squad 4365, P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN and I, was dispatched to a shooting complaint at Onyx Night Club, located at 3120 W Villard Av.; located in the City and County of Milwaukee. Squad 4340, P.O. Nathan WOODS and P.O. Violeta TENHAKEN, responded to St. Joseph's Hospital, located at 5000 W. Chambers St, to interview the victim, identified as Cameron T PRATHER B/M, 05-19-93 address of 6223 W Port Av; Milwaukee, WI 53223, cell phone #414-202-9273.

Squad 4312, Sergeant Jeffrey DOLKIEWICZ, assisted Squad 4340 (P.O. WOODS and P.O. TENHAKEN) with interviewing the victim at St Joseph's Hospital, and Squad 4313, Sergeant Michael HAYDEN, assisted P.O. MCCLAIN and me at Onyx Night Club.

Upon our arrival at Onyx Night Club, I interviewed the Manager, identified as Obiora C OBI B/M, 08-18-76 address of 4830 N 47th St; Milwaukee, WI 53218, cell phone# 414-788-7705. My interview of OBI was conducted in his Manager's Office. Obiora OBI was not under the influence of drugs or alcohol, was forthcoming with pertinent information that was imperative to this investigation, and maintained a clam demeanor.

Interview of Obiora C OBI B/M, 08-18-76

Obiora OBI appeared perplexed when I advised him that we were investigating a shooting that allegedly occurred outside of his tavem. OBI stated his security staff and himself was unaware of anyone being shot outside of Onyx Night Club. Furthermore, OBI stated no patron advised his security personnel that they observed a shooting or were a victim of a shooting. He then alerted us to his security camera system. Obiora OBI has a LTS digital camera system. His LTS digital camera system records in exact time. The camera system is absent of auditory sound; furthermore, the camera system has sufficient quality. P.O. MCCLAIN, Sergeant HAYDEN, and I, viewed cameras 1,2, and 3, from approximately 3:00 AM to 3:40 AM. Aforementioned cameras capture W Villard Av., from N 31st St. to N 32nd St. While observing the cameras, I observed at approximately 3:29 AM. two black males, early 20's, one with braided hair to the back, were engaged in a verbal altercation outside the main entrance. Several other unknown black male subjects begun to intervene. Soon thereafter, approximately 10 to 12 subjects began pushing each other momentarily. I did not observe any punches thrown. The subjects dispersed in different directions. Moments later, several subjects then reassembled in the parking lot directly across from Onyx Night Club. Due to the distance in proximity, and the absence of sound, I was unable to determine if any further altercation occurred. However, after viewing the camera system, I did not see anyone armed with a handgun. Obiora OBI advised me that he will have a copy of the incident downloaded onto a USB port to be picked up within a day.

I then interviewed the exterior Security Officer identified as Derek A WEILER W/M, 08-01-79. WEILER is a contract Security Officer and is employed by City Wide Public Safety.

Interview of Derek A WEILER W/M, 08-01-79

Derek WEILER stated he was assigned mobile patrol of Onyx Night Club. WEILER stated he did not observe any altercation with patrons during the aforementioned time frame. He stated that no patron approached him advising him of any shooting. WEILER stated he did hear several gunshots, from a distance, during the inauguration of the new year. Derek WEILER did not have any further pertinent information pertaining to this incident.

Squad 4313, Sergeant HAYDEN, searched the parking lot directly across from Onyx Night Club, and the surrounding immediate area, and did not find any blood or casings.

After conducting interviews of OBI and WEILER, I spoke with P.O. Violeta TENHAKEN regarding her interview of the shooting victim, previously identified as Cameron T PRATHER B/M, 05-19-93. P.O. TENHAKEN advised me that PRATHER was uncooperative and abstained from giving complete facts regarding being shot. After conversing with P.O. TENKAKEN, a synopsis of her interview of PRATHER was as following. PRATCHER stated he was crossing southbound, across W Villard Av, from Onyx Night Club, when he heard several gunshots. Cameron PRATHER stated at this time he noticed he was shot to his left leg. PRATHER stated he knocked on several car doors in an attempt to get assistance. PRATHER stated and unknown person, operating an unknown vehicle, drove his girlfriend and him to St. Joseph's Hospital where he received medical attention. PRATHER abstained from giving any further details.

This License Premise report is concluded.

This report is written by PO Matthew BOUZEK, assigned to District Four Late Shift on Squad 4365, along with PO Jonathan MILLER.

On Sunday, January 31, 2016 at 1:53am, PO MILLER and I were dispatched to the location of 3120 W Villard Ave (Onyx Night Club), regarding a Fight/Battery complaint.

Upon arrival, PO MILLER and I began speaking with the victim of this incident, Milton C RAYFORD (b/m,09-04-1987). RAYFORD suffered a noticeable contusion to his left eye, and he requested medical assistance. RAYFORD eventually stated to the Police that he was robbed in the bathroom of the Onyx by an unknown b/m. RAYFORD stated he was physically assaulted in a stall of the bathroom, and was robbed of his \$2,000 (Robbery complaint filed under IR#16-031-0019).

I, PO BOUZEK, went to our marked Squad car (238), which was parked on W Villard Ave facing westbound, and was parked approximately 20ft from the main entry door. I proceeded to conduct a wanted check of RAYFORD. Approximately five minutes later I heard two gunshots relatively close by our current location, and observed patrons of the nightclub beginning to flee out of the main entry doors. I immediately secured my Squad car, and with my firearm drawn, PO MILLER and I entered the nightclub through the main entry doors along with other Officers.

The club was tactically cleared in search of any active shooter(s), and for possible victims. A victim was reported to be on the ground in the northeast bar/dance area, so our clearing efforts took us to this location of the nightclub. I observed and confirmed a shooting victim, Stephan M. CAMPBELL (b/m 08-26-88), who suffered a gunshot wound to his right leg. After the interior was secured, the victim of the gunshot was evaluated by the Milwaukee Fire Department, and conveyed to Froedtert Hospital.

An Onyx security guard, Melvin WILSON (b/m, 09-19-1976), stated the following:

WILSON stated he was working near the front door when two individuals began yelling at each other. WILSON stated he and another security guard, he identified as Leonard JONES also helped escort the subjects from the nightclub. WILSON remembered the main actor in this argument. This subject was described as a black male 5'5"- 5'6", light complexion, 26 or 27 year old, medium build, short natural hair cut, wearing white jacket with a colored design around the collar area, blue jeans, a faint goatee or facial hair, and a possible white t-shirt.

WILSON stated that approximately 10 or 15 minutes later the bar lights were turned on and people were headed towards the door. WILSON remembered observing this individual attempting to make his way back into the bar. A fight started inside the bar and WILSON remembered observing this subject back inside the bar, fighting with others. WILSON remembers this individual swinging (punching) at others WILSON stated that he did not see a firearm but heard two gunshots inside the bar area. The first gunshot was heard in the front bar area. WILSON recalled the second gunshot at a separate location. WILSON did not see anyone holding a firearm.

The crowd then began moving away from the front door and moved towards the dance floor area. WILSON encountered a person shot in the dance floor area. WILSON attempted to calm people down and stood by with the victim until the police arrived on scene.

This report is written by P.O. Tracey Geniesse assigned to District Four, Day Shift.

On Monday, February 6, 2016 at 11:10 AM, we held a meeting in regards to a shooting that occurred on January 31st, 2016 (Inc# 160310017). The meeting was held at District Four, in the Sergeant's office.

Present for this meeting was myself along with P.O. Carrie Resnick, Lt. Phil Hanyard, ACA Nick Desiato, Sgt Chad Raden, Obiora Obi, Richard Lucas and Jerrel Jones.

Nick started the meeting, stating since Onyx had reopened, there really hasn't been any serious incidents until now. He went on to explain the importance of communicating with District Four, so the Onyx doesn't continue to have incidents and have consequences for them at the next licences hearing.

Lt. Hanyard spoke of the incident, as well as a robbery that occurred the same evening in the men's bathroom. Lt. Hanyard addressed there were twelve squad cars that responded to this incident. He stated "these are all serious issues and they are major concerns!"

Richard (Security) stated the promoter for this event, promoted known gang members from the "Burleigh Zoo", of which Onyx staff and security were unaware of this until a group of them showed up at the last minute. Lucas stated everyone who entered that night were patted down twice and scanned once.

Obi stated when the victim of the robbery entered the club, he had money hanging out of his pockets, so security advised him to put it on the inside of his pockets, but the victim continued to flash his money all night. He was then robbed in the men's bathroom. Obi stated he was pushed by the victim when he was trying to leave, that's when Obi observed blood on the victim and Obi advised the victim that he would call the Police. Obi stated everyone who came into the club was searched, but not scanned. He stated they have become more "lax" to searching people. Nick stated, if it was in your plan, you MUST implement.

Sgt. Raden explained how promoters will advertise on Facebook and other social media sites without the owners knowledge. He suggested to check the clubs name on different social media sites. This will help deter future incidents, so if it's seen on a site and it is targeting a group of known gang member at the last minute, they can cancel.

Richard stated if they have one more incident, they will consider changing the age limit again. Jerrel stated "Everyone knows I will turn in my license if this stuff continues to happen, and we need to discuss changing the age limit."

Obi was able to show us the video of the incident that occurred, however, the video only showed a few subjects pushing past security to get into the club, a few sceonds later everyone was running out. There was no sound to the video and it did not show anything past the doorway.

Obi stated he will send in a new security plan through email, and continue to work with District Four. He stated staff has been going out into the neighborhood and cleaning up garbage after the weekends. He is also hiring a tow company for vehicles that park infront of driveways, those vehicles will be towed.

This concluded the meeting.

This report was written by P.O. Moua VANG, assigned to D4, Late shift.

On Saturday, 2/13/16, Squad 4365 (P.O. VANG and P.O. HERNANDEZ) were dispatched to a subject with gun complaint at the address of 3120 W Villard Ave (Onyx Night Club), in the City and County of Milwaukee.

While enroute, the Caller Aided Dispatch (CAD) stated the firearm was in the suspect vehicle, a black Honda Accord bearing WI Lic# 202XYZ.

Upon arrival, I did observe a green 1996 Honda Accord bearing WI Lic# 202XYZ parked in front of the Onyx Night Club with the vehicle running, the key still in the ignition and the headlights of the vehicle activated. I observed an open Hennessy Cognac 750ml glass bottle on the floor of the passenger side front seat that was almost empty. In plain view, I observed a dark color handgun half way underneath the passenger side front seat with the muzzle of the handgun pointing outward towards the Hennessy bottle.

I interviewed Willie L HUMPHREY (b/m, 9/21/78) inside the Onyx night club regarding.

Interview of Willie L HUMPHREY (b/m, 9/21/78)

HUMPHREY is employed by the Onyx Night Club as security. HUMPHREY stated prior to our arrival, the subject later identified as Devin L COOPER (b/m 5/6/93) was intoxicated and acting belligerent inside the Onyx Night Club, bumping into other patrons while on the dance floor and acting disorderly. HUMPHREY stated after COOPER lost his wallet inside the club, he became contentious and began accusing everyone of taking his wallet.

COOPER was removed from the Onyx Night Club by security and while outside, they told COOPER's 24 years old, b/m friend Jariah LAMP (no further info), who was also on scene to drive COOPER's car, a green 1996 Honda Accord bearing WI Lic# 202XYZ, to the front of the night club to pick up COOPER and leave. LAMP agreed to do so and drove the vehicle to the front. HUMPHREY stated as COOPER continued being belligerent walking towards his vehicle passenger side, he eventually opened the passenger side door of his vehicle and began reaching inside the vehicle to grab something. HUMPHREY stated he observed COOPER place a semi-automatic handgun into his right side waistband. HUMPHREY stated he began advising COOPER not to do it. COOPER, who was boisterous, eventually reconsidered and threw the handgun back into the passenger side seat area.

HUMPHREY stated as patrons walked by, COOPER became hostile to them and began accusing them of stealing his wallet. COOPER was then detained by security as the police was called. LAMP left the scene on foot soon afterwards.

End of interview

COOPER stated many times that he has indeed been drinking and that he was intoxicated. COOPER also stated he was licensed to carry a concealed weapon but the license was in his wallet which he lost. COOPER was arrested and placed in the rear of our squad car.

A DOT check of the vehicle reveal COOPER was the owner of the green 1996 Honda Accord. COOPER's vehicle was towed for safe keeping (TOW#1632764) and the black and chrome .40 caliber Taurus semi-automatic handgun loaded with 6 bullets, recovered underneath the passenger

side seat of COOPER's vehicle, a green 1996 Honda Accord bearing WI Lic# 202XYZ, was placed on MPD evidence inventory (INV#16005366).

COOPER was licensed to carry a concealed weapon (license # 244027, issued 01-17-2015, expires 01-17-2020).

COOPER was given an intoximeter test by Squad 4320 (P.O. BAAKE, PS# 008352), which revealed COOPER'S blood alcohol content (BAC) to be .09.

This report is written by PO Moua VANG, assigned to District Four Late Shift on Squad 4365, along with PO Ralph MCCLAIN.

On Saturday, February 27th, 2016 at 1:14am, PO MCCLAIN and I were dispatched to the location of 3120 W Villard Ave (Onyx Night Club), regarding a shots fired complaint.

While enroute, per the Caller Aided Dispatch (CAD), Onyx security had a b/m subject wearing a red jacket in custody with a firearm recovered. Upon arrival, Squad 4330 (PO L EVANS and PO SCHLEI) were already on scene and had secured the firearm and had taken the subject into custody. The subject was identified as Cedrick T ROLLINS (b/m,3/5/89, 5628 N 95th St).

I interviewed one of the Onyx Security guard Derek A WEILER (w/m, 8/1/79, 807-2450) who stated prior to the shooting, there was a fight that broke out between several subjects in the Photo Booth area room. After the individuals involved were separated by security and force to leave the club, moments later, he heard about 3 or 4 shots fired coming from outside of the club. WEILER stated he exited the night club to the outside and observed an armed Onyx security guard running on foot Southbound down N 32nd street from W Villard Ave in pursuit of a subject, later identified as ROLLINS. They eventually caught up to ROLLINS and detained him. WEILER was related by the armed security guard that he heard a gun drop near by while they were pursuing ROLLINS. WEILER stated after checking the area, he observed a firearm on the ground. ROLLINS had an injury on his left shoulder and was taken to St. Joseph Hospital by Medicare #204.

I returned to Onyx and requested to see the video surveillance of the incident. This is a summary of the video surveillance. For the full and detailed investigation, see the original reports and view the video in whole that will be placed on MPD inventory by CIB.

At about the 1:08:30 time marked in the video dated 2/27/16, cam 30 reveals a fight that occurs in the Onyx photo booth room between several patrons. Security is seen breaking up the fight and multiple subject are removed from the club.

At about 1:09:00 time marked, on the cam 3, a larger b/m subject, later identified as ROLLINS from the design on the front of his shirt, who was removed from the club due to involvement in the fight is observed running southbound across W Villard Ave and south on N 32nd St. The ROLLINS is observed returning at 1:09:48 time marked and gives a hidden object believe to be a firearm to another b/m subject. ROLLINS and the other b/m subject are observe attempting to re-enter the Onyx night Club but was refused.

At about 1:10:40 time marked, a b/m subject with dreads who was involved in the fight is observe exiting the Onyx night club and jogging southbound across W Villard Ave and south down the alley leaving the club. ROLLINS is observed running after the b/m with dreads, pulls a firearm hidden from his waistband and points it in the same direction the b/m with dreads had ran and open fire 3 times into the alley way at 1:10:42 time marked. Afterwards, ROLLINS is observed running westbound on W Villard Ave and then southbound on N 32nd St as 2 security guards are observe pursuing on foot.

PO MCCLAIN informed D4 acting Lt. Sgt. HARDING regarding and squad 7350 (PO ORTEGA and PO STURMA) responded as primary regarding the shooting. CIB was notified who also responded.

BREWSTER stated she blew her horn at the group of girls in attempts to get them to move. BREWSTER stated the group of girls began to punch her to her face and against her body through the passenger side window. BREWSTER stated the operator driver side door was unlocked, and the girls were able to gain access to the inside of her vehicle. BREWSTER stated the girls dragged her out of her car and continued punching her. BREWSTER stated an unknown light skinned b/f, unknown birthdate, unknown description, fired one shot in the air from an unknown type of firearm. BREWSTER stated she feared for her safety. BREWSTER stated she had never seen the female before 04-24-16. BREWSTER stated the female took off in an unknown vehicle traveling in an unknown direction. BREWSTER stated the female was the cousin off the 3 females that were standing by the blue Toyota.

I spoke with the driver of the Toyota. She identified herself as Charmaine E. THOMAS (B/F, 06-05-94). THOMAS stated that she had nothing to do with the incident. THOMAS stated she did see the victim fighting with an unknown black female, but she didn't know the females name. THOMAS stated she didn't know where the unknown female had fled to. THOMAS stated she didn't hear any gun shots. THOMAS stated she had a CCW permit and she was in possession of a firearm in her vehicle.

Upon looking in THOMAS's vehicle I observed on the front passenger seat a Sar Arms EAA 9mm semi auto handgun (serial#T1102-14G08848). The slide was black and the grip was black. It had a magazine containing eleven 9mm Luger bullets inside the magazine well. There was one Luger 9mm bullet in the chamber for a total of 12. There was no odor of gun powder on the gun or in the vehicle. THOMAS stated she brought the gun 2 weeks ago.

BREWSTER was transported by Paratech Ambulance, Squad 206 to ST. Mary's Hospital. BREWSTER was admitted on 04-24-16 at 2:28 A.M., and treated by Doctor Robert RIEPENHOFF. BREWSTER received stitches to her left lower lip.

While my partner P.O. Lisa BAAKE and I were conducting follow up at the hospital, BREWSTER stated she wouldn't be able to identify the unknown black female out of a photo array.

Sgt Jeffrey DOLKIEWICZ was on scene during the investigation.

Lisa BAAKE took photos of the scene and the victim.

No bullet casings were recovered from the scene.

I contacted District Seven, Late Shift, Lt. CHARLES in regards to the incident.

This License Premise report was written by P.O. Shaletta WHITERS, assigned to District Four, Late Shift, and Squad 4340.

On April 24, 2016 at approximately 2:01 A.M., my partner (Lisa BAAKE) and I were on patrol in the area of 32nd and W. Villard Ave, (Onyx) in the City and County Of Milwaukee.

We were traveling eastbound on W. Villard Ave, just south of the Onyx when we heard one gun shot. The gun shot sound to have come from the parking lot that is just southwest of the Onyx. A group of individuals stated "They are fighting' P.O. Lisa BAAKE immediately via radio contacted the Milwaukee Tele- Communications Dispatch System in regards to the incidents, and requested more Squads to the scene.

Upon exiting the Squad, we accessed the scene and saw that the Onyx security guards were requesting for the crowd to disburse and leave immediately. I observed approximately 30 to 40 individuals in the parking lot. They appeared to be compliant and going to their vehicles to exit the premises.

I observed a 2009 Nissan Altima (plate# 720UXX) with the driver side door open unattended facing westbound. I observed there were black hair extensions sitting to the west off the bumper of the vehicle. To the far southwest of the parking lot I observed four black females standing by a 2012 blue Toyota Prius (plate#462XHJ) that was parked facing southbound. Three of the four females appeared to be getting into the vehicle. I observed the fourth female standing in front of the car facing north hysterically stating "She's with them, they let her leave." I observed that the female had blood coming from her mouth, and the left side of her bottom lip was busted. She had blood on the front of her dress, and her hair appeared to be ripped out on the left side.

Upon speaking with the female she identified herself as Tashauna L. BREWSTER (B/F, 04-01-91) and the victim of the Sub Battery. BREWSTER stated she didn't want medical services. After I and P.O. Lisa BAAKE offered medical services again she accepted. BREWSTER stated that on 04-24-16 at the above listed address she proceeded to leave the Onyx night club and get into her 2009 white Altima. BREWSTER stated her cousin was in the passenger seat of the vehicle with the window down. BREWSTER stated as she attempted to leave the parking lot, an unknown group of 4 black females began to dance right in front of her vehicle preventing her from exiting.

This report was written by P.O. Brian LaROQUE, assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift. On Sunday, May 8, 2016 at 2:15am I responded to 3120 W Villard Av (Onyx Night Club) for a complaint of a shooting. During the investigation we determined that a shooting did not occur but that there were shots fired within the parking lot utilized by customers from Onyx and a Substantial Battery that occurred within Onyx.

A concert was preformed by Lil Boosie the night and there was a crowd of approximately 350 persons attending. During the night at approximately 2:10am a fight started within Onyx that would continue outside of the tavern. The victim in the incident was knocked unconscious and required stitches to close a wound he received.

While the fight was going on outside of the tavern two other individuals fired off a total of 14 rounds of ammunition in the parking lot utilized by the customers of Onyx. A total of three firearms were recovered to include a stolen handgun, and an AK47 style assault rifle. A total of five arrests were made and in addition to the firearms recovered officers also recovered 17 grams of Cocaine Based powder and 3 grams of Marijuana.

OBI identified himself as the owner of the nightclub. Upon review I observed that OBI holds the Food Dealer License but not the Tavern License. When I asked OBI to tell me who his bartenders were for the night he stated that he did not know. When I asked OBI how many security guards he had present for the event he stated that he does not handle security at all and that I would have to talk with LUCAS or SMITH regarding. OBI stated that LUCAS handles exterior security and that SMITH handles the security inside. I then asked OBI for a count of the total number of employees working and he stated that he did not know. OBI was instructed to contact me via email with the additional information and was reminded via email to do so on 5/9/16. As of 5/11/16 OBI has failed to provide me with this information. I also informed OBI that he was in violation, as he did not have a sign posted with the Cover Charge.

I made contact with Jerrel W JONES (Agent on the Class B Tavern License) and informed him of my concerns and findings. I informed JONES that he was going to be getting a warning for the violation. JONES stated that he would contact OBI in an attempt to gather additional employee information for me.

Blood was located inside of the bar where the fight first started prior to it moving to the street outside of the club.

HUMPHREY stated that the subject that made the threat to go get a gun was a black male, approximately 5'7, 145lbs, dark complexion, wearing all white and a red baseball cap. This subject was no longer on scene upon squads arrival. A search of the area of this subject and the other subjects yielded negative results. Squads on scene set up for traffic control to alleviate the congestion that follows the club's let out of patrons at the end of the night.

There were no other incidents on this night at the venue.

This report was written by P.O. Brian LaROQUE, assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift. On Saturday, May 21, 2016 at 12:48am I was instructed to respond to 3120 W Villard Av (Onyx Night Club) to monitor the tavern. Squad 7468 (P.O. Douglas PAVLIK and I) as well as Squad 7464 (P.O. Eric NORDSTRUM and Daniel TIERNEY) responded to the location. I conducted a tavern check at the location to show police presence in an attempt to prevent any issues from occurring throughout the night.

During the check I noted that Krystal N HILL (B/F, 10/21/85) was tending bar at the front bar and that she did not have a Class D Bartenders License. At this time I spoke with Obiora C OBI (B/M, 8/18/76) regarding the violation. OBI then stated that he was there and that HILL was working as a bartender under his license. It should be noted that OBI holds the Food Dealers License in his name and does not have a Class B Manager License, A Class D Manager License, and the Tavern License is not in his name.

At 1:50am the security staff at Onyx forced multiple subjects out of the tavern that were engaged in a physical altercation. During this time they continued to fight in the roadway on W Villard Av. While trying to clear the fight using emergency lights and siren I heard two shots fired. I later learned that officers attempted to stop a subject who entered his vehicle and struck an officer. An officer on scene fired into the suspect auto and it fled the scene and I initiated a vehicle pursuit of the suspect auto. This is an ongoing investigation and for additional details please refer to incident report #161420017.

OBI remained on scene and allowed officers to access to the security camera footage.
