Dear Council Members:

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) is reconstructing North 76th Street from West Clinton Avenue to West County Line Road in 2008 under the Federal/State Aid program. Permanent Street Lighting Facilities will be installed by the City in conjunction with the paving project. The total estimated cost of the street lighting project is \$346,472.26, which the WISDOT will fund 100% of the total cost.

Therefore, we have prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Local Force Account (LFA) – Local contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install permanent street lighting facilities in conjunction with the paving of North 76th Street from West Clinton Avenue to West County Line Road in the 9th Aldermanic District.
