PUBLIC WORK COMMITTEE ITEM 22, FILE #080732 **SEPTEMBER 24, 2008**

File #080732 authorizes the execution of a Revised Project Agreement between the City and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation ("WISDOT") for the rehabilitation of the East Lincoln Avenue Viaduct over the Union Pacific Railroad in the 14th Aldermanic District. The project is eligible for 80% federal and/or state aid, with a City match of 20%, under the Local Bridge Program. Construction costs have been refined and increased since the prior agreement was executed in August 2004. This Revised Project Agreement ensures 80% grantor participation at the higher total project cost.

BACKGROUND

The Local Bridge Program was established to rehabilitate and replace, on a cost-shared basis, the most seriously deficient existing local bridges on Wisconsin's local highway and road systems. Counties, cities, villages and towns are eligible for rehabilitation funding on bridges with a sufficiency rating less than 80, and replacement funding on bridges with sufficiency rating less than 50. Under the program, federal and state funds cover 80% of specific individual project costs and are matched by 20% local funding. Each county is responsible to review and prioritize eligible bridge projects within that county.

The East Lincoln Avenue Viaduct over the Union Pacific Railroad had a sufficiency rating of 63.6 in 2007. The Viaduct is on the *'Approved 2009-2012 Local Bridge Project List'* issued by WISDOT.

DISCUSSION

CCFN 991756 authorized the execution of the original Project Agreement with WISDOT for the East Lincoln Avenue Viaduct project. The file authorized the expenditure of \$392,000 for preliminary engineering/design work, with the City being responsible for \$78,400 of this amount. (Design costs ultimately totaled \$417,000, with a City share of \$83,400.) This file also authorized the City to seek additional Local Bridge Program funds in the future for construction costs.

CCFN 040864 authorized the execution of a Revised Project Agreement dated August 24, 2004. Construction costs totaling \$3,370,000 were now included in the contract with WISDOT, assuring 80% grantor coverage of these expenses. Assuming these projected construction costs, City participation of \$674,000 would be required when the project was ultimately undertaken.

This file authorizes the execution of a Revised Project Agreement dated July 21, 2008 to reflect increased total construction costs to \$5,750,000. Under the Local Bridge Program, the grantor share will now be \$4,600,000 and City participation will be \$1,150,000.

FISCAL IMPACT

This resolution has no immediate fiscal impact as construction funds for this project will be requested in a future resolution. Under the Revised Project Agreement, ultimate city participation will total \$1,150,000. This project has a scheduled let date of December 14, 2010,
