File #080636 is a resolution authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Public Works to enter into formal service contracts to allow Buildings and Fleet Services to maintain already authorized service levels.

## BACKGROUND

- DPW uses formal and informal (vendor contracts) service contracts. Under formal contracts, vendors provide a service over a specific period of time. Under informal contracts vendors provide a service for specific jobs for a short period of time. Informal contracts are bid out on a per job basis.
- 2. DPW uses formal contracts to provide certain services including custodial, security guard, elevator maintenance, and maintenance of building computer systems including access control, mechanical systems control and fire safety systems.
- 3. DPW has utilized informal contracts for carpentry, masonry, painting, floor coverings, landscaping, mechanical systems repair, moving services and plumbing.

## DISCUSSION

- 1. DPW has determined that it would be more efficient to increase the number services provided through formal service contracts.
- 2. This resolution authorizes DPW to enter into formal contracts for certain services that have been provided in the past through informal contracts referenced under #3, Background. In addition, the resolution also authorizes DPW to enter into formal contracts for electrical and board-up services. According to DPW, the proposal to contract out for daytime board-ups (File #080432) that was held at the July 16, 2008 Public Works Committee meeting will not be implemented.

## FISCAL IMPACT

This resolution has no fiscal impact.
