The bartender Regan stated that the female bought a bottle of wine from him and that when she drank it, she began to twitch her head and act strangely. Later at the hospital the 20 year old female stated that she was not asked for ID. She also stated that she took "liquid g" or GHB, a central nervous system depressant, along with the alcohol which rendered her unconscious.
