Resolution commending Pastor Robert C. Randolph for his contributions to Milwaukee's All Things In Common Initiative.

WHEREAS,

PASTOR ROBERT C. RANDOLPH

played a critical role in organizing and implementing Milwaukee's All Things In Common Initiative in August 2016; and

WHEREAS, *Pastor Robert Randolph founded and is the Senior Pastor at Kingdom Faith Fellowship in Milwaukee, is a respected leader and humanitarian in the city, and continually reaches out to the forgotten; and*

WHEREAS, *All Things In Common is a city-led partnership focused on establishing "community resource hubs" to provide direct services like group-based mentoring and referrals to city services for driver's license recovery, child support mediation and other critical services and in-kind resources from philanthropic partners, and brought Milwaukeeans together in the spirit of neighbors helping other neighbors to get by; and*

WHEREAS, *Pastor Robert C. Randolph was a key leader in creating and launching this initiative, working with Milwaukee's Common Council to establish various sites across the city, and his hard work and contributions included naming the initiative, creating the logo, assisting with marketing, and gathering and coordinating other pastors for the partnership, and he established his own church – Kingdom Faith Fellowship – as one of the community resource sites; now, therefore, be it*
