There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 9/6/2016 at 10:45 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



On the evening of Thursday, February 26, 2015 through the morning of Friday, February 27, 2015 District One personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. The officer's who participated in the operation were Police Officer Christopher Martin, assigned to District One, Police Officer Dorian Andress assigned to District 3, and myself. For the underage persons in this initiative we used one MPD police aide who works in the Police Administration Building. Police Aid Teresa Westfahl assigned to the Police Academy. Westfahl was confirmed to be underage by her Wisconsin identification card (2/17/1996)

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed class B tavern establishments the police aide and plain clothed police officer were given instructions. Westfahl and Andress were told that they were not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. They could not lie if asked if they were underage, or show any form of documentation, which could be construed as identification. It was explained that they had to order an alcoholic beverage, directly from a bartender behind a bar, then meet the plainclothes officer observing them with the alcoholic beverage for a photo in the tavern and then leave together. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes officer shadowing them would be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages.

After this briefing Martin and I escorted P.O. Andress who was in plainclothes and P.A. Westfahl to multiple taverns located throughout the District One boundaries.

Westfahl and Andress attempted to gained entry to the class "B" licensed tavern, Rosie's located at 1111 N Water St. Westfahl and Andress was challenged at the point of entry and turned away when Westfahl couldn't prove she was of age.

I notified Jackie Peterson that they passed.

While on scene, P.O. DUMMANN spoke with the bouncer for Rosie's Bar, Brian J. TICAR, W/M, 9-11-81, who relayed the following information regarding the incident. TICAR stated that he was working the front door for Rosie's that evening and WILKS had come in earlier in the evening. TICAR stated that WILKS had been drinking heavily, but had not been causing a disturbance inside or outside the bar. WILKS then went outside the bar and was standing on the front steps to the bar when he fell backwards and hit his head on the sidewalk. WILKS immediately started to bleed from the back of his head and Rosie's staff called for medical attention.

On the evening of Friday, August 7, 2015 through the morning of Saturday, August 8, 2015 District One personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. There were three teams that were part of this initiative. Each team had an MPD Police Aide, a Police Officer, both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity with a uniformed Police Officer or Sergeant monitoring from a short distance. The Police Aide for each team was under the age of 21. This was verified by their respective Wisconsin driver's license. All plainclothes members of this initiative submitted a sample of their breath to a PBT test before and after the initiative. All members registered 0.0% BAC.

After the briefing, the teams conducted underage checks at multiple taverns and convenient stores located throughout the District One boundaries.

Police Officer Karlee Kennon, Police Aide Chelsey McDowell attempted to gain entry to the class "B" licensed tavern, Rosie's Waterworks located at 1111 N. Water St. Police Aide McDowell was challenged at the point of entry and turned away when she couldn't provide identification.

On Wednesday, August 19, 2015 at 12:37 a.m.,I, Police Officer Mariolys Flores informed Brian Ticar, shift manager that they passed. While at the tavern, I asked Ticar if they had an ID scanner, at which time Ticar replied that they did not.

On 02/18/16 at approximately 7:18 PM the Dept of Revenue and myself conducted an inspection on Rosies Bar located at 1111 N Water St. When I entered the bar it was open with about ten patrons inside drinking. I observed one bartender behind the bar actively attending as a Bar Tender. I identified the subject by Wisconsin Drivers License as Matthew S BLUME (w/m 03/05/81) when asked for his Bartender License BLUME informed me that he didn't have one.

BLUME was working in the establishment alone at this time with no supervision from any other employee or licensee. The bar was temporally closed until the licensee arrived on scene, James P PACK (w/m 08/12/68).

The bar was given a full inspection by The Dept of Revenue with the following discrepancies, no licensed operator, 13 bottles of contaminated liquor (fruit flies in bottles), no invoices available for inspection as required by law for past two year of operation, three illegal video gaming machines (gambling) and proof of liquor refilling (large Patron bottles used to fill smaller bottles).

PACK was given a copy of the field report and explained all discrepancies noted on the form. I cited BLUME for no having a class D bartending license, and PACK for having his tavern open and operating for the sale of alcoholic beverages without a responsible licensed person on premises




