Your Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and Public Entertainment Premises License Applications with 25+ Age Restriction Requesting Jukebox and Patrons Dancing as agent for "Rose Serene LLC" for "Courtside Bar & Grill" at 9012 W Silver Spring DR.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

- 5. On 06/24/2005, at 12:29 AM, PO Murray and PO Albritton were dispatched to investigate a Fight at Steve-O's tavern located at 9012 W Silver Spring Dr. Investigation revealed that two Patrons became involved in an argument that led to pushing and shoving in the female's restroom. A third patron later identified as b/f BASS, Tamisha D. (08/19/1979), picked up a 3-4 " glass ashtray an threw it at the victim striking g on the fore head causing a laceration. Suspect left the scene prior to Officers arrival. Warrant request file for Battery against Tamisha Bass. No further information available.
  - 6. On 08/31/2005, PO Kaminski, PO Simmert, PO Navrrette and Police Aide T. Mantsch, conducted an underage buy at Steve-O's located at 9012 W Silver Spring Dr. PA Mantsch ordered 3 cans of Miller Lite beer from the Bartender on duty, w/f Hemmen, Holly A. (12/25/1964). Bartender served Pa Mantsch W/o asking for proof of age. Bartender was cited for sale of Alcohol of Alcohol to underage person.

On 05/13/2006 at 2:05am, squads were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at Steve-O's. 9012 W Silver Spring Dr. Upon speaking to the bouncer he stated he heard several gunshots outside the business and walked outside to observe a b/f heavy build with a silver handgun. Officers spoke to a female patron who stated the b/f was shooting in her direction as she walked up to her car.

8. On 08/28/2006 at 11:00pm, a sergeant observed the front entrance of Steve-O's, 9012 W Silver Spring Dr., to be propped open. The licensee, Steve C CONZONER (04/13/1948) was contacted about this violation and stated he could only recall once about a month ago when police asked him to close the door. No citation issued.

- 9. On 01/18/07 at 2:08 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 9012 W Silver Spring for an Armed Robbery complaint. Officers spoke to the caller who stated he was robbed outside of Steve O's tavern. The victim was uncooperative with police and refused to provide requested information by police. Officers spoke to the bartender, Timothy Anderson, who stated to police that around 2:00 am several patrons got into an argument inside the tavern at which time Anderson told them to take it outside. Anderson stated all the parties involved exited the tavern and that he observed them arguing in front of the tavern. Anderson stated several minutes later, one of the patrons re entered the tavern and asked to use the phone. Detectives arrived on scene and took over the investigation.
- 10. On 04/13/07 at 2:09 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 9012 W Silver Spring for a Battery/Cutting complaint. Investigation revealed several patrons argued inside the tavern with the fight continuing outside in the parking lot. A subject was found to have been stabbed. Police spoke to the manager, identified as Timothy Anderson, who stated there was a fight inside the tavern and all patrons were told to leave because it was closing time. Anderson stated approximately 2 minutes later someone was knocking on the door requesting an ambulance because someone was stabbed in the parking lot.
- 11. On 06/22/07 at 11:30 pm, Milwaukee police were flagged down by a citizen regarding a Fight at 9012 W Silver Spring, Steve O's Tavern. Police responded to the location and were told by a citizen that people were fighting in the bar. Officers spoke to the manager Timothy Anderson who stated there was a group of females and males fighting in the back of the bar. Anderson further stated he tried to break up the fight but couldn't because there were to many people fighting. When police arrived, they observed no individuals who were injured or wanting to file a complaint. The bar owner Steven Conzoner, arrived as police were leaving and he was advised of the incident that took place.
- 12. On 07/23/07 at 12:36 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 91<sup>st</sup> and Silver Spring for an Armed Robbery complaint. Police spoke the victim who stated he left Steve O's bar and was in the parking lot where he car was parked when he was approached from behind by an unknown male armed with a semi-automatic who demanded the victims personal belongings. The suspect then fled. Police spoke to Steven Conzoner who stated he was unaware of the robbery and that the victim did not summon security personnel.
- 13. On 10/06/07 at 2:19 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 9012 W Silver Spring for a Shots Fired complaint. As police arrived, they observed three females fighting in the middle of the street with a large crowd gathering outside of the tavern. Citations were issued to the women for Disorderly Conduct. Officers checked the area for signs of shots fired and located 12 .22 caliber casings on the ground in the parking lot of Steve O's. The casings were placed on inventory.


- 14. On 11/17/07 at 1:47 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 9012 W Silver Spring for a Battery complaint. Police spoke to the victim who stated a known actor struck her in the face several times causing pain while she was inside the Steve O's tavern. A citation was issued to the known suspect for Assault and Battery. Police spoke to an employee of the tavern who provided the licensee information being requested.
- 15. On 03/01/08 at 2:07 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 91<sup>st</sup> and Silver Spring for a Shots Fired/Subject With Gun complaint. Police spoke to the doorman at Steve O's tavern, identified as Terry Hermon, who stated there was an argument in the parking lot but that everyone had left prior to police arriving. Hermon stated no one had a gun and that there were no shots fired. Other witnesses stated that no shots were fired and no one was fighting.
  - On 05/07/07 the applicant was charged with OWI in Milwaukee County. His license was revoked for 7 months.
  - 16. On Thursday, August 27,2009 at 1:37AM, Milwaukee Police Department was sent to Steve-O's Bar And Grill at 9012 W Silver Spring Dr for a fight complaint. Police observed the victim lying on the ground on his back at the rear of the tavern with a large laceration to the back of his head. He stated he was beaten and robbed by a subject named "Demarco" and second unknown subject. "Demarco" and the victim were in the tavern earlier drinking.
  - 17. On the following dates and times, a License Premise Check was conducted by Milwaukee police and no violations were observed:

- 18. On 08/29/2013 Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 9012 West Silver Spring Drive (Steve O's) based on a complaint received from the Department of Health Services regarding a violation of the Wisconsin Indoor Clean Air Act. Officers observed an ashtray on the bar in the business and reminded the applicant that smoking is prohibited in the building. No additional reports were filed.
- 19. On 08/31/2013 at 2:20am Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 9012 West Silver Spring Drive (Steve O's) regarding a violation of the Wisconsin Indoor Clean Air Act as well as the sale of carry out liquor. Officers discovered two people leaving the business, each carrying an unopened can of beer. The two told officers they had bought the beer at the bar, but that the bartender was unaware that they had left the business with the beer. The applicant was discovered inside the business smoking a cigarette and was told about the complaint. The applicant told officers he sells six packs of beer to patrons to carry out until midnight and was not aware that two patrons had left the business with beer after midnight. No additional reports were filed.

- 20.On 04/29/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a property damage complaint at 9012 West Silver Spring Drive (Steve O's Bar). Investigation revealed a former employee damaged a television inside the business as well as several windows. Milwaukee police incident report #141190146 filed.
- 21.On 10/12/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 9012 West Silver Spring Drive (Steve O's Bar). Investigation revealed a patron of the bar punched the bouncer in the face when the bouncer attempted to escort the patron out of the business. The patron was cited.
- 22.On 03/28/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 9012 West Silver Spring Drive (Steve O's Bar). Investigation revealed that a patron of the bar attempted to rob another patron at gunpoint while in the men's room at the business. A struggle for the gun ensued and the victim was shot in the leg.
- 23. On 04/24/2015 Milwaukee police, along with agents from the Department of Revenue and Department of Neighborhood Services, conducted a tavern check at 9012 West Silver Spring Drive (Steve O's Bar). During this check, the agent from the Department of Revenue had the applicant dispose of 19 bottles of liquor due to health infractions with the bottles.

If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


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



The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 12/13/08, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise check at 2436 N Martin L. King Jr, Drive. Officers spoke to the owner Tiny Martin who provide officers the tavern licenses which were all valid. A check of the bartender's license was also found to be valid. No violations found.
- 2. On 02/06/10 at 12:36 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 112 W Meinecke for a Battery complaint. Investigation revealed the victim, who was a patron at Tiny's Lounge, was approached by her ex-boyfriend and became upset when the victim stated she did not want to get back together. The suspect then pushed the victim to the ground, which caused a fracture to arm. The victim was treated at a nearby hospital and charges were pending against the suspect.
- 3. On 09/23/2015 officers went to Tiny's Lounge, 2436 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr, for a tavern check based on a complaint it was open without a license. The officers found patrons in the tavern being served fermented malt beverages. A check of the posted licenses revealed a Provisional class B which expired on 07/21/2015. The Bar Manager was Timothy DAY and he provided a B Manager license which expired on 06/30/2015. DAY stated the applicant was sick and living in Mississippi. The applicant stated DAY was in charge and thought he completed the renewal paperwork. The bar was closed that night. On 09/28/2015 the class B was renewed as was the B Manager license for DAY.

4. On 12/30/2015 officers went to Tiny's Lounge, 2436 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr, for a tavern check based on a complaint the applicant had turned in her license due to another individual running the establishment. The officers arrived and found the bar open and being run by the licensed B Manger, Timothy DAY. DAY did not know the applicant had turned in the license and stated he was unaware of a problem that caused her to turn in the license. He called her on the phone and confirmed her wish to close the establishment.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/07/2015 Milwaukee police spoke to Arthur Strong, identified as security personnel, who stated there had been shots fired within the business after an altercation between patrons. Strong stated a patron struck another patron and caused a disturbance. Strong attempted to physically intervene when he overheard and unknown subject shout "Go to the car". Strong observed a subject re-enter the bar with what appeared to be a firearm with a black handle and chrome barrel. Strong observed the subject pointing the firearm at patrons. Strong discharged his own firearm into the ceiling to stop the suspect's actions. The suspect fled out the bar and fired his firearm at the bar. No patrons were struck during this altercation. Strong was ordered into the District Attorney's office were it was determined his actions were non-criminal
- 2. On 03/20/2015 Milwaukee police, along with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a premise check at 8775 North 107<sup>th</sup> Street (Club 107). During this check, the bartender, Dannielle Klinter, was given verbal warnings regarding invoices for alcohol and for combining or refilling bottles. The bottles that had been combined or refilled were disposed of.
- 3. On 10/05/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a sick/injured person at 8775 North 107<sup>th</sup> Street (bar 107). Investigation revealed a patron had fallen off a patio table. Milwaukee police incident report #152770043 filed.

- 4. On 01/09/2016 at 12:33am Milwaukee police were dispatched to a subject with a gun complaint at 8775 North 107<sup>th</sup> Street (Bar 107). Investigation revealed there was an altercation at the business when security barred a subject from entering that would not produce identification or follow other tavern policies. The subject made a gesture with his hand simulating a gun along with threatening statements "You think you bad man, I'm going to get you" and told the bar manager he was "going to shoot her". This subject fled in a black four door vehicle prior to officer's arrival. Milwaukee police incident report #160090034 filed.
- 5. On 01/09/2016 at 2:24am Milwaukee police were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at 8775 North 107<sup>th</sup> Street (Bar 107). Officers observed two windows had been shattered. Inspection revealed what appeared to be bullet holes in the shattered window. Officers also discovered a bullet casing in the street along with bullet fragments inside the business and what appeared to be bullet strikes on the ground in front of the business. One of the business's employees told officers he was taking out the garbage when he heard gunshots and observed a vehicle in front of the business. This vehicle, a black four door, matched the general description of a vehicle described in item #4. Milwaukee police incident report #160090017filed.
- 6. On 01/22/2016 Milwaukee police met with Kelly Lewis, manager for Bar 107, at the business in regards to shots being fired into the tavern. Lewis described an incident that occurred about a week before the shots fired involving a couple of customers who refused to leave and the business's security. This incident turned physical and the subjects made unknown threats prior to leaving. This incident was not previously reported to police. Kelly stated they have since hired a new security officer and are considering other changes, such as an age limit of 25 or older and changing juke box settings. She further stated they generally have a good clientele and do not have problems. She also expressed willingness to work with police.

MANNING stated that he observed that the subject was very intoxicated and he called for medical attention.

I observed that the bar was closing up arrival and had few patrons left.

PO KRAMSCHUSTER did speak to YOUNGBLOOD who stated that he had been drinking tonight and tried to twerk on the table and fell. YOUNGBLOOD was transported to Froedtert Hospital for medical care. Please refer to incident report for more information.

This Disorderly Conduct, License Premise report, was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS# 015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Saturday, January 9, 2016, at 12:33 A.M., Squad 4365, P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN and I, were dispatched to a Subject With Gun complaint at 8775 N. 107th St, Bar 107. The caller stated that two suspects, both black males, approximately 30 years old, one wearing a Packers shirt, and the second wearing a white hat, were outside the tavern fighting. Furthermore, caller stated the suspect wearing a white hat brandished a handgun. Responding Squads were then advised that the suspects dispersed from the tavern and were possibly running towards Trackside Inn, located at 8762 N Granville Rd.

Upon my arrival, Squad 4410, Sergeant DIX and I, checked Trackside Inn, located at 8763 N Granville Rd, and Sheehan's, located at 8741 N Granville Rd, and did not observe anyone matching the aforementioned suspects description. I then changed my location to Bar 107 to ascertain investigatory statements from the complainants.

Upon my arrival, I interviewed the plain clothes Security Officer, identified as Ryan J MANNING B/M, 08-31-83 address of 8601 W Denver Av; Milwaukee, WI 53224, cell phone# 414-828-8880. My interview of MANNING was conducted in the lounge area of the tavern. Ryan MANNING was not under the influence of drugs or alcohol, was forthcoming with pertinent information regarding this investigation, and was well-spoken.

Ryan MANNING stated on Saturday, January 9, 2016, at approximately 12:20 A.M., Suspect #1, described as a B/M, unknown name, 28-34, 5'7", 180, medium built, dark complexion, facial hair (style unknown), wearing a green tee shirt, and a predominantly green and white skull cap, came through the main entrance demanding to use the bathroom. MANNING stated the suspect refused to present his identification or state his name. Ryan MANNING stated he denied the suspect access for failing to comply with the tavern's policies. MANNING stated, soon thereafter, he was momentarily distracted by a female patron yelling abruptly. Ryan MANNING stated when he turned his head, the aforementioned suspect attempted to walk past him.

MANNING stated he grabbed the suspects by his arms then forcibly escorted him through the foyer, and into the parking lot. He stated Suspect #1 grabbed him by his sweatshirt and refused to let go. MANNING stated he advised Suspect #1 to let his shirt go. He stated Suspect #1 replied, "You think you are bad man, I'm going to show you." Ryan MANNING stated afterwards, the tavern patrons intervened and separated them. MANNING stated his co-worker, who is also a Security Officer, identified as Lamont L BRINSON B/M, 07-12-86, assisted him during the altercation by not allowing Suspect #1 associates to intervene. Ryan MANNING stated Lamont BRINSON and he went back inside the bar for their personal safety and locked the door. MANNING stated from the picture window, he observed Suspect #1 attempting to get through the main entrance door. He stated Suspect #1 was being held back by patrons. MANNING stated he heard Suspect #1 state, "I'm coming back to get you." He stated Suspect #1 made a hand gesture simulating a gun. MANNING stated Suspect #1 threatening statements and hand gestures caused him to fear for his safety.

Ryan MANNING stated Suspect #1 acquaintances escorted him out of view. MANNING stated he began to focus on the location of Bar 107 Manager, identified as Kelly J LEWIS W/F, 01-06-78 address of 8036 W Green Tree Rd; Milwaukee, WI 53223, cell phone# 414-595-8306. MANNING stated he lost track of Kelly LEWIS during the altercation with Suspect #1. He stated moments later LEWIS entered the foyer area.

I then interview Kelly LEWIS in the kitchen area of the tavern. LEWIS was not under the influence of drugs or alcohol, maintained a calm demeanor, and was well-spoken.

Kelly LEWIS stated she was in the lounge area (located on the south side of the tavern) when she observed the physical altercation between MANNING and Suspect #1. She stated after the crowd disbursed, she observed an acquaintance of Suspect #1, identified as Suspect #2- B/M, unknown name, 23-30, 5'8" to 5'10", 170-190, medium built, dark complected, wearing a white knit hat, dark and light gray checker-style flannel shirt underneath a black jacket, and dark jean pants, leave the parking lot in a black Nissan Altima, 4dr, bearing WI registration plate of 892-WVY, then drove to the parking lot of Trackside Inn. LEWIS stated preceding leaving the Bar 107 lot, she took a picture of the back of aforementioned vehicle.

Kelly LEWIS stated during the altercation between MANNING and Suspect #1, she notified the police. LEWIS stated after Suspect #2 parked his vehicle in Trackside Inn parking lot, he proceeded to walked across the street and back into Bar 107 parking lot. Kelly LEWIS stated she retreated back into the doorway. LEWIS stated Suspect #2 approached the door then stated, I'm going to kill you, I'm going to kill you." She stated after Suspect #2 made aforementioned threat, he pointed his index finger directly at her. Kelly LEWIS stated Suspect #2 threat caused her to fear for her safety. LEWIS stated she request to prosecute Suspect #2 for making threats against her personal safety.

Afterwards, Kelly LEWIS escorted me to their digital camera system located, in a room off the lounge area. The camera system was identified as a Crown XLS 1000. LEWIS stated the Crown XLS 1000 records in exact time. The system is absent of audible sound. Furthermore, this incident was captured on Cameras titled as following:

Front Parking Lot 1- captures the overall parking lot, mounted on the north east side of building. Front Park Lot 2- captures the central location of the parking lot, mounted centrally on the east side of building. Front Park Lot 2- captures the south end of the parking lot, mounted on south east side of the building. The Crown XLS 1000 captured the following incident.

12:17:00- Suspect #1 and Suspect #2 arrives in the aforementioned black Nissan Altima. Suspect #1 exits the passenger side of the vehicle, on the north side of the parking lot, and walks towards the front entrance. Suspect #2 parks the car in the parking lot, facing westbound. Suspect #1 enters through the foyer area. Ryan MANNING conducts a pat down of suspect. Moments later, appears that words are being exchanged between Ryan MANNING and Suspect #1. Soon thereafter, MANNING grabs Suspect #1 by his arms and escort him out the tavern. Suspect #1 and MANNING are observed pulling on each other clothes while in the parking lot. Multiple patrons are in the parking lot attempting to pull Suspect #1 away from MANNING. Kelly LEWIS is observed taking a picture of Suspect plates during the altercation. Moments later MANNING is observed reentering the tavern. Suspect #1 dispersed.

12:23:55- Suspect #2 enters the Nissan Altima then drives off the parking lot. Moments later, Suspect #2 is observed walking across the street towards Bar 107. Kelly LEWIS is standing on the south side of the parking lot and appeared to be conversing on her cell phone. LEWIS makes visual contact with Suspect #2 then walked into the main entrance. Suspect #2 walks to the main entrance, gesture something with his hand and makes a statement to LEWIS, prior to walking away.

Kelly LEWIS was unable to access the camera system because the owner was out of the country. However, LEWIS stated the owner will be back on Monday, January 11, 2015. I advised Kelly LEWIS that P.O. MCCLAIN and I will obtain a copy of the incident on Wednesday, January 13, 2015.

A subsequent Department of Transportation check revealed the Nissan Altima is registered to Charles R BROWN B/M, 01-06-86 address of 9609 W Allyn St #5; Milwaukee, WI 53224. Charles BROWN physical and facial features (dark brown complected and beard) are similar to Suspect #1. As perviously stated, Suspect #1 was the actor who was initially observed exiting the passenger's side of the vehicle.

P.O. MCCLAIN interviewed Victim #3, identified as Lamont L BRINSON B/M, 07-12-86 address of 7740 W Appleton Av; Milwaukee, WI 53222, cell phone# 414-553-2076.

P.O MCCLAIN spoke with security personnel of Bar 107, Lamont L. BRINSON, b/m, 07-12-86, who stated that at approximately 12:15 am, he was sitting just inside the front entrance of the bar monitoring patrons. BRINSON then stated he heard a lot of commotion right at the doorway of the establishment. He noticed a patron was becoming really loud and boisterious with the other security personnel on duty that night (Ryan J. MANNING, b/m, 08-31-83). BRINSON stated he heard MANNING tell the subject, "Dude, I can't let you in without an ID." He stated that he heard the subject state to MANNING, "Dude just let me use the bathroom". BRINSON stated that when MANNING told the subject no, the subject tried to push his way past MANNING, who grabbed the subject by the arm and escorted him out the door. BRINSON stated that once he observed MANNING escort the patron out the bar, he followed MANNING and the subject out the door.

BRINSON described this subject as a black male, mid to late 20's, 5'7 to 5'8", medium build, dark complexion, wearing a green shirt (possibly Packers on the front), and a winter skull cap. BRINSON stated once outside, the above described subject continued yelling obscenities and threatened to kill MANNING. BRINSON stated when he stepped over towards MANNING (because of MANNING's escalating aggression) another black male subject came up and got into his face. BRINSON described this subject as mid 20's, 5'8" to 5'9", medium build, med to dark complexion, wearing a skull hat, a black jacket, and dark jeans.

BRINSON stated the subject made threats to kill him and stated several times to him "Don't get your ass whooped out here". BRINSON stated that the two subjects continued yelling obscenities for about 5 to 10 minutes more outside the front door of the bar. He stated both kept walking up to the front door and windows to the bar, pointing and making hand gestures as if they were pulling the trigger of a gun in him and MANNING's direction. BRINSON stated he also heard Subject #2 above tell the bar's manager that he was "going to shoot her". BRINSON stated he then returned to the inside of the bar to monitor patrons left inside.

This incident occurred in the City and County of Milwaukee. Follow-up will be conducted with Photo Arrays depicting Charles BROWN as the Target pictorial.

This case is pending.

This License Premise report is written by P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN (PS#015494), assigned to District Four, Squad 4365, Late Shift. On Saturday, January 9th, 2016, at 2:24 am, I, along with my partner, P.O. Martinez MOORE (PS#015951) responded to a Shots Fired call at the address of 8775 N 107th St. This establishment is called Bar 107 and is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I observed the front 65x74 window by the front door shattered. I then observed a second 65x74 window shattered in the foyer of the bar. I also observed shards of glass on the ground directly in front of the entrance and in the foyer. Closer inspection of the window revealed what appeared to be two bullet holes at the bottom of the second shattered window. There was also what appeared to be a bullet strike on the concrete parking guard directly (approximately 20 feet) in front of the entrance to the bar. Continuing investigation revealed a bullet casing in the street (N. 107th St), near the curb, directly in front of the establishment. There were two bullet fragments found in the bar (under a pool table and by a bar stool in the bar. There was also a bullet fragment found in the parking lot, near the walkway, in front of the bar.

I first spoke with the victim, Lamont L. BRINSON, b/m, 07-12-86, 7740 W. Appleton Ave, who stated that at approximately 2:20 am, on the above day and date, he took a bag of trash out the front door of the bar. The garbage dumpster is located in the southeast corner of the parking lot. BRINSON stated that as he stepped off the walkway in front of the bar, he noticed a "Suburban-type" SUV that is sitting towards the south end of the parking lot. He observed a white male and white female subject talking to each other outside of the vehicle. BRINSON stated that as he reached approximately the middle of the parking lot, he heard one gun shot which made he stop suddenly and duck. BRINSON stated he then heard another gun shot and hears the female subject outside the vehicle say "I think someone is shooting". BRINSON stated he quickly glances over towards N. 107th and observed a black, 4dr vehicle, (not sure of the make or model and no plate description) parked on N. 107th St, directly in front of the establishment.

BRINSON stated he did not see who was inside of the vehicle. BRINSON stated that he threw the bag of trash in his hands toward the dumpster. He stated he quickly ducked down behind the SUV in the parking lot. BRINSON stated he looked back over at the vehicle parked on N. 107th St from behind the truck and immediately hears an additional two to three gun shots in rapid succession. BRINSON stated he observes muzzle flashes from a gun from the front passenger window. He stated that he immediately ducked back down then hears tires squeal. BRINSON stated he then observed the vehicle that was parked on N. 107th St speed off south bound from the bar. BRINSON stated he ran quickly back into the bar.

It should be noted that the above listed vehicle is the same color and "body style" of the vehicle that two black male subject who were disorderly earlier in the morning occupied and operated.

It should also be noted that BRINSON stated an unknown subject attempted to enter the bar earlier but did not possess identification. This subject was refused admittance and as a result became very angry and volatile. This subject he stated began making threats verbally "I'll kill you" and via hand gestures (as if firing a gun). BRINSON stated that this subject, along with another unknown subject, eventually left the premises. For a full detailed narrative of this incident see Disorderly Conduct report IR#16-009-0034.

I spoke with the manager of Bar 107, Kelly J. LEWIS, w/f, 01-06-78, who stated that she was out on the floor of the bar talking to someone with she heard a loud crash. LEWIS stated that she thought someone threw a brick through the window initially. LEWIS stated that she thought it (the person who committed this act) was the subjects that had threatened her and her security staff a couple or so hours earlier (see Disorderly Conduct report IR #16-009-0034). LEWIS stated she called police after hearing the loud crash. LEWIS stated that she did not know that someone had actually shot into the bar until she talked her security staff and after looking at the surveillance video. LEWIS stated that she is almost certain that the black vehicle parked on N. 107th St, in front of the bar, was the same black vehicle (2011 4dr, Nissan Altima, WI registration plate 892WVY) was the

same vehicle that the disorderly subject and another subject parked in the bar's parking lot and exited from earlier.

P.O. MOORE and I viewed the video surveillance from this incident on Saturday, January 9, 2016. On the establishment's Crown XCS 1000 video surveillance system, at 12:19:34 am the black aforementioned vehicle appears in the frame. The vehicle is traveling south bound on N. 107th St from the left side of the frame of the video. The vehicle then stops directly in front of the bar at 2:19:46 am. Moments later, the passenger side window rolls down. At 2:22:45 am, BRINSON enters the frame, walking across the parking lot with what appears to be a trash bag in his hand. An arm appears out the passenger side window as if it is pointing in BRINSON's direction. At 2:22:48 am a faint flash appeared from the passenger window and then are three bright flashes that appear from the window. Then moments later, the vehicle quickly drives off south bound at a high rate of speed.

A copy of this video could not be obtained at the point of viewing due to the copying system being locked in a room that LEWIS did not have access to at the time. The owner of the bar was out of the country and will be returning on Sunday, January 10, 2016, according to LEWIS. Follow up will be done in order to obtain a copy of the video related to this incident at that time.

Casings and bullet fragments were place on MPD inventory (#16001031).

Supplemental reports regarding witness statements will be filed regarding.

This report is written by P.O. Tracey Geniesse assigned to District Four, Day Shift on Squad 4164, along with P.O. Carrie Resnick.

On Jan. 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 at 10:00 AM, P.O. Carrie Resnick and I met with Kelly Lewis, who is the manager for Bar 107. We were the only ones present for this meeting. We met at the establishment, in regard to a shots fired into the tavern.

Kelly stated she was working the night of the incident, but there was an incident with a couple of customers about a week before this incident, and she was not working. She stated her unnamed security guard was trying to clear out the bar at closing time, and there were two black males subjects, who were not done with their drinks when the security guard advised them they had to leave. Kelly stated they were refusing to leaving, when the security guard took their drinks and poured them out. They still refused to leave, so the security guard grabbed one of the subjects and it started to get physical. The subject eventually left, but some unknown threats were made. This incident was never called into the Police. She stated one of the subects returned on January 9<sup>th</sup> later in the evening attempting to come into the tavern, but was refused service for unknown reasons. Some words and threats were made, but the subject along with another subect left the location. Later that evening, just before closing is when the shots were fired into the building (report number 160090017).

Kelly stated they have hired a new security officer. They are considering changing the age limit to 25 and older. They are also looking into changing the jute box settings. When customers arrive, before entering the the tavern, security conducts a pat down of all males, and the females are wanded. She stated they generally have a good clientele, and do not have problems. She is willing to work with the Police Department when issues arise.

- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
