Dear Council Members:

The 2008 Capital Improvement Program includes the installation of traffic control signal improvements including the installation of pedestrian countdown timers at the subject intersections in conjunction with geometric changes under the 2008 Safe Routes to School Program.

The total estimated cost of the project is \$51,189.31. One hundred percent of the total cost will be funded by the Wiscons in Department of Transportation (WISDOT).

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Local Force Account (LFA) – Local contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install traffic control signal improvements at the intersections of West Forest Home Avenue, West Oklahoma Avenue, and South $43^{\rm rd}$ Street in the $8^{\rm th}$ and $11^{\rm th}$ Aldermanic Districts.
