neighbor's house. The fence was put up without a permit and exceeds the city's building code

that limits fence height at this location to 4 feet.


The applicant wants to keep the fence at this location. He will either cut down the fence to meet the 4 foot height requirement or install a lattice panel that will meet code. He is also considering removing the current fence and installing a metal picket fence. All three options would be appropriate.

Any wood fence must be painted or stained upon completion.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 



Board and lattice, also called a "treillage fence"

Either of these two options would be appropriate. Any portion of the fence over 4 feet tall needs to be 50% open. Cutting down existing fence is also an option.
