1) Please provide an executive summary of your business.

Include:

- Business plan for the business or businesses to be located at 2368
 N. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive (the "Property")
- List all revenue sources for the business that will operate onsite at the Property
- Whether any of your proposed uses will require a special use permit or license for the premises and if so, explain.
- Explain how the second floor will be utilized.
- If your plan includes a housing component, please identify specific plans for type of housing, including unit and bedroom counts, and describe the site design for the housing component
- Why does this particular location interest you for your business? Would you consider alternative locations?

2) Please identify a parking plan for your business.

Include:

- How many parking spaces will be needed to support the business, patrons and employees
- Whether parking needs will vary, including whether additional spaces will be needed for events or overflow use
- Indicate where you expect to find the parking needed to support the business and any overflow needs

3) Please submit a detailed scope of work, budget and financing plan Include:

- Confirmation of the proposed purchase price for the Property
- Detailed scope of work
