There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1) On 08/15/95 at 11:00PM Officers passed by Taylor's located at 797 N. Jefferson St. and observed the doors open. The Officers entered the tavern, and advised the employees that the doors must be kept closed after 10:00PM. On 08/16/96 the Officers went back to Taylor's and advised the licensee Daniel Taylor about the incident on the previous night. He stated that he understood. On 08/22/96 the Officers again passed by Taylor's at 10:40PM and observed the doors open. Mr. Taylor was on the scene and became uncooperative when informed he was going to receive a citation, and asked why he was not warned regarding the offense.

2) On 07/16/96 the Utilities and Licenses voted to recommend granting of the Class B Tavern License, and sent the applicant a warning.

Note: The applicant failed to pay the fine in regards to item #1 Case #95083832 and a warrant was issued on 08/06/96. On 08/28/96 the case was dismissed without prejudice due to a plea agreement (see item #3).

On 07/10/96 at about 11:30PM Officers observed the Southern-most door of the East side of Taylor's (797 N. Jefferson St.) propped open. The Officers observed the door standing open for about 10 minutes without anyone making an attempt to close it. The bartender John Mertins stated that he had closed the door at about 10:00PM, and that a patron must have left it open. A verbal warning had been issued on 06/25/96 regarding an open door violation. The licensee was not on the scene.

- 4) INCIDENT: On Saturday, 02/21/98 at 1:50AM Officers were dispatched to a fight at Taylors located at 797 N. Jefferson St. Upon their arrival Officers found that a fight had taken place inside the tavern between two subjects. After the initial confrontation one of the subjects exited the tavern, and was confronted by two or three other subjects. At this time another fight took place. A person who attempted to stop the fight was also struck in the face. Two subjects were issued citations for Disorderly Conduct, and One subject was issued a citation for Assault & Battery.
- On Sunday, 08/02/98 at about 12:45AM Officers observed an employee hold open the front door to Taylor's tavern located at 797 N. Jefferson St. From about 12:45AM to 1:22AM the Officers monitored the tavern. At no time did the doorman close the door. At times patrons, and employees did exit and enter through the front door, however the traffic was not heavy enough to require the door being held open. At about 12:58AM the Officers observed three Males exit the tavern carrying bottles of fermented malt beverages, and a glass of fermented beverage. It did not appear that any employees made any attempt to prevent them from leaving the premise with the open bottles or glass. The three subjects continued across the street where they were stopped by Officers. The subjects admitted that they walked out of the tavern with their drinks, and no one attempted to stop them. The licensee was not on the scene, but the Officers spoke to James S. Taylor who stated he was not aware that anyone had left the premise with alcohol. He also stated that he advised the doorman to keep the front door closed. The three patrons were issued citations for public drinking.

13. On 07/03/09 at 10:15 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Trouble With Subject/Theft complaint at E Lyon and N Van Buren Streets. Investigation revealed a bouncer from Taylors observed a patron stealing money from another patrons purse who then left the tavern. The bouncer, identified as Nickolas Cuda, followed the suspect along with two other bouncers and detained him until police arrived. The money was recovered and the suspect was arrested. charged and later found quilty of theft.

14. On 12/16/10 at 12:30 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 795 N Jefferson Street for a Battery complaint. Police spoke with the victim who stated while inside the tavern she was approached by an unknown female who was yelling profanities at her, and acting aggressively to toward her, for unknown reasons. The victim stated the female then struck her in the face causing pain and discomfort. The female then left the bar and the victim followed and they fought again when the victim's cell phone fell to the ground and the female picked it up and fled the area. Witnesses did talk to police regarding this incident.

15. On 03/29/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight. Investigation revealed that while a patron at Taylor's Bar (795 N. Jefferson Street) the victim's wallet was removed from his pocket by two females. The victim followed the suspects to Catch 22 where he observed the suspects using his credit card to purchase drinks. The victim confronted the suspects and a fight ensued. The two suspects were arrested. Milwaukee police incident report #150880021 filed.

- 16. On 06/12/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a battery complaint at 795 North Jefferson Street (Taylor's Bar). The victim told officers he had been punched and pushed down some stairs by an unknown assailant while a patron at the business. The victim was uncooperative with officers and stated he did not want to file a report. Milwaukee police incident report #151630010 filed.
- 17. On 08/07/2015 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to Taylor's (795 North Jefferson Street) but was turned away at the door when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
- 18. On 12/12/2015 a citizen appeared at the city of Milwaukee Municipal court entrance to report a battery. The victim, Matthew Rusch, told officers he had been a patron at Taylor's (795 North Jefferson Street) with his girlfriend, Amy Schuldt, when he was approached and struck in the face by a subject, Justin Moralez, that was interested in pursuing a romantic relationship with Schuldt. Rusch was conveyed to St. Lukes hospital where he received two stitches. Milwaukee police incident report #153460027 filed.

This report is written by P.O. Jennifer RAMOS assigned to District 1-Late Shift.

On March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at apooximaltey 12:55AM, while assigned to Squad 1320, I was dispatched along with Squad 1331 P.O. Paul GEITTMANN, to meet Squad 1410 Sgt. Thomas ACKELY regarding a Fight

Upon arrival I observed squad 1411 (Sgt. Thomas Ackley) already on scene near the intersection on N. Milwaukee St. and E. Mason St. Sgt. Ackley appeared to have two females, later identified as Sherika J. Haynes (b/f 03-09-87), and Lisa B. HAYNES (b/f 08-23-65) in custody.

P.O. GEITTMANN then informed me that he spoke with the victim, Mohamed B. Taleb (W/M 6/20/88), told him that the two deatained females were using his credit card without his permission. TALEB stated that prior to police arriving he comfortmed the females inside Catch 22 about taking his debit card. TALEB stated that an argument started and continued outside. During this argument, a bartender at Catch 22 Thomas E. Zamjahn (W/M 6/17/85) observed the two females then attacked TALEB and start physically fighting on the sidewalk, until Police arrived.

TALEB further explained that while he was at Taylor's Bar, 795 N. Jefferson St. earlier in the evening. the two blacks females, approached him. He stated that they both put their arms around his waste and pulled him closer to them. He stated one of them, he could not remember which, said to him "baby why don't you come home with us?" TALEB stated that he told them that he was not interested and they walked away and immediately left the bar. TALEB stated that about ten seconds later he noticed that his wallet was missing out of his front right pocket and he suspected that the two females had taken the wallet.

TALEB stated that he saw the two females leave and followed them as they left, eventually getting to Catch 22 on N. Milwaukee St. TALEB stated that as he got there he saw one of the females about to use his credit card to pay for drinks but he did not remember which female he saw. He stated that he then went into the bar and told the staff that the females were using his credit card.

During the invesitgation,P.O. GEITTMANN spoke with the barthender at Catch 22, Alexander GROVE (W/M 11/24/82) who stated that the two females came into the bar and ordered two drinks. One of the females, whom he identified as Lisa HAYNES, handed him a credit card to pay for the drinks. He stated that he did swipe the card, which resulted in it being charged for the drinks, and handed it back to her. He stated that Lisa HAYNES then signed the receipt and gave it back to him. It was just after this that he was informed by TALEB that the credit card was actually his.

Lisa HAYNES and Sherika HAYNES were arrested and charges referred to the District Attorney. (ARS 15-088-0021, 15-088-0013)

This report is written by Police Officer Mariolys Flores, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift.

On the evening of Friday, August 7, 2015 through the morning of Saturday, August 8, 2015 District One personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. There were three teams that were part of this initiative. Each team had an MPD Police Aide, a Police Officer, both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity with a uniformed Police Officer or Sergeant monitoring from a short distance. The Police Aide for each team was under the age of 21. This was verified by their respective Wisconsin driver's license. Police Aide Laura Nirode (PS 024687, DOB 06/15/95), Police Aide Elizabeth Sauer (PS 024693, DOB 08/11/1994), PA Chelsey McDowell (PS 024685, DOB 08/16/94), PO Karlee Kennon (PS 021519), PO Dorian Andress (PS 019758) and PO Kira Williams (PS 019786) were in plainclothes while PO Mariolys Flores (PS 024325), PO Zachary Johnson (PS 022614) and Sergeant Thomas Ackley (PS 018520) were in full uniform.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments the Police Aides and Police Officers were given instructions. All plainclothes members of this initiative were advised they are not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. If asked about their age, the members were told to tell the truth. The Police Officers were directed to produce ID's, but the underage Police Aides were directed to not produce any form of identification. It was explained that the Police Aide was to order an alcoholic beverage. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes Police Officer should be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages. All plainclothes members of this initiative submitted a sample of their breath to a PBT test before and after the initiative. All members registered 0.0% BAC.

After the briefing, the teams conducted underage checks at multiple taverns and convenient stores located throughout the District One boundaries.

Police Officer Kira Williams and Police Aide Elizabeth Sauer attempted to gain entry to the class "B" licensed tavern, Taylor's located at 795 N. Jefferson St. Police Aide Sauer was challenged at the point of entry and turned away when she couldn't provide identification.

On Wednesday, August 19, 2015 at 2:37 a.m., Police Officer Zachary Johnson informed Colin Philipps, assistant general manager that they passed. While at the tavern, P.O. Johnson asked Philipps if they had an ID scanner, at which time Philipps replied that they did not.

#### PA-33E Narrative

This report is submitted by P.O. Daniel ZOLO assigned to District 1, Late Shift.

On Saturday December 12, 2015, P.O. Daniel O'CONNELL was assigned to Squad 1396, Municipal Court security. At approximately 3:23 am, the victim (Matthew A RUSCH) walked into the Municipal Court entrance to report a battery. Also present with RUSCH was his girlfriend, Amy J SCHULDT.

RUSCH stated that he was struck in the face at bar time while inside Taylor's, a bar located in the City and County of Milwaukee at 795 N Jefferson St, by Justin M MORALEZ. SCHULDT explained that MORALEZ had been pursuing a romantic relationship with her for approximately two years and was jealous of the romantic relationship between RUSCH and SCHULDT. SCHULDT stated the relationship between she and MORALEZ had never been anything other than a friendship.

SCHULDT explained that she and a friend had been at an event downtown and then went to Taylor's after the event had ended. SCHULDT and her friend arrived at approximately 12:30 am and happened to see MORALEZ along with a group of male friend's of SCHULDT's. SCHULDT explained that MORALEZ had become intertwined into her group of friends in the past two years and occasionally saw each other at gatherings. SCHULDT stated that she made small talk with MORALEZ and her friends after she had arrived at the bar.

RUSCH stated he arrived at Taylor's at approximately 1:30 am and immediately noticed MORALEZ outside of the bar. RUSCH remarked that MORALEZ appeared to be staring him down as he entered the bar. RUSCH stated that MORALEZ was jealous because RUSCH was in a romantic relationship with SCHULDT and MORALEZ wanted to be in RUSCH's position. SCHULDT explained that she told MORALEZ that she was meeting RUSCH here and wanted to spend her time with him only. SCHULDT remarked that MORALEZ appeared to be upset when she told him.

RUSCH explained that after he had arrived at the bar, he and MORALEZ had no interaction. RUSCH stated that at bar time, he began to exit the bar to meet SCHULDT outside to grab a ride home. RUSCH alleges that MORALEZ stopped him from exiting the bar and without saying a word; MORALEZ struck him in the face without his consent. RUSCH stated that as MORALEZ fled, he struck MORALEZ. MORALEZ then fled down the street to a cab and left in an unknown direction.

RUSCH stated that he and SCHULDT came to the district station to file a report regarding the incident. BELL 415 provided brief medical care to RUSCH's wounds. P.O. Jeremy LIMBERG took photos of the victim's wounds.

I (P.O. Daniel ZOLO) conveyed RUSCH and SCHULDT to Aurora Saint Luke's hospital. RUSCH was admitted to the hospital at 5:07 am and was treated by Dr. William Lieber. RUSCH received two stitches under the care of Dr. Lieber



The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- On 12/13/08, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise check at 2436 N Martin L. King Jr, Drive. Officers spoke to the owner Tiny Martin who provide officers the tavern licenses which were all valid. A check of the bartender's license was also found to be valid. No violations found.
- 2. On 02/06/10 at 12:36 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 112 W Meinecke for a Battery complaint. Investigation revealed the victim, who was a patron at Tiny's Lounge, was approached by her ex-boyfriend and became upset when the victim stated she did not want to get back together. The suspect then pushed the victim to the ground, which caused a fracture to arm. The victim was treated at a nearby hospital and charges were pending against the suspect.
- 3. On 09/23/2015 officers went to Tiny's Lounge, 2436 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr, for a tavern check based on a complaint it was open without a license. The officers found patrons in the tavern being served fermented malt beverages. A check of the posted licenses revealed a Provisional class B which expired on 07/21/2015. 




