4. Results Measurement/Progress Report (Applies only to Programs):

The Rivera Drug Trafficking Organization (DTO) was identified as a distributor of kilogram quantities of heroin and cocaine in and around the metropolitan area of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The DTO supplied narcotics to several different criminal organizations on the south and north sides of the City of Milwaukee, as well as surrounding municipalities. The organization was known to supply heroin, cocaine, and marijuana to Spanish Cobra and Latin King gang members, as well as others not specifically associated with any type of street gang, yet were integral in street level narcotics distribution. Beginning in February of 2016, case agents began monitoring and investigating this organization's key members. Along the way, agents were able to identify approximately 40 members, as well as several overdose deaths linked to the group's narcotic distribution. In June of 2016, the investigation culminated with 17 federal arrests, 8 federal search warrants, resulting in the seizure of 16 firearms, nearly \$150,000 in currency, numerous high value assets, as well as narcotics. The investigation remains open and is ongoing.
