 - Police Officer: 2 classes of 50-65
 - Police Aide: 1 class of 35
 - Firefighter: 1 class of 35
 - Fire Cadet: 1 class of 26
- Background investigations
 - Outsourcing this function to improve efficiency in the hiring process
 - Continued involvement from MPD in follow-up process
