Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this bearing

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 11/02/2012, a Milwaukee Police Department squad was dispatched to Milwaukee Nights Pub at 3830 W National Av for an entry complaint. During the investigation the agent was very cooperative and no violations were observed during this incident.
- 2. On 11/12/2014 at 7:34pm Officers were dispatched to 3830 W. National Av (Milwaukee Night Pub) to investigate an Armed Robbery. The investigation revealed 3 males entered the bar from the side door and immediately pointing guns at the patrons and the bartender. Money was taken from the register and the subjects fled through the west door. The applicant arrived on scene prior to the Police. He was cooperative during the investigation. The cameras were not functioning during the incident.
- 3. On 02/15/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a trouble with a subject complaint at 3830 West National Avenue (Milwaukee Nights Pub). The caller told officers that an unknown male became aggressive after being told to leave the business when he was caught attempting to steal change from other patrons from the top of the bar. This subject threatened to come back and shoot up the bar. The suspect fled when told that police had been called. During this contact, officers observed no tavern violations.

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


