There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.





This report is written by PO Seth EDWARDS, assigned to District 1, Late Power shift.

On Saturday, December 05, 2015 at approximately 1:00 AM, Squad 1430 (myself) was flagged down by a security member from the NOVO security team at the intersection of N. Water St and E. Juneau St for subjects fighting in front of Buffalo Wild Wings, located at 1123 N. Water St, which is in the city and county of Milwaukee.

Upon my arrival, I observed a security member of NOVO'S security team who was later identified as, Mazin M. SHERID (B/M 11-19-93) who had the subject, who was later identified as Lyth B. SAEED (W/M 05-29-94), detained on the steps of Buffalo Wild Wings. As I approached SHERID and SAEED I contacted dispatch to notify them of my location. SHERID stated that the subject had a gun. I observed the subjects hands were behind his back but un-cuffed. SAEED was able to get to his feet and I immediately took control of his left arm while SHERID controlled his right. I asked SHERID where the gun was on SAEED and SHERID stated that it was in his waistband on the backside of his waist. I immediately located the gun where SHERID stated it was and removed it from his body with my right hand. SAEED attempted to move to his right and I took control of SAEED with my left hand around his torso. SHERID and I guided SAEED to the ground. I contacted dispatch while on the ground with SAEED and stated that I was on the ground with the SAEED that I had removed a gun from him and that he was un-cuffed. Squad 1445 (PO Eric BRANDT) arrived first on scene and I passed the gun to him. PO BRANDT took control of the gun I removed from SAEED. I took control of SAEED'S right arm and placed it behind his back. SHERID took control of his left arm and placed it behind his back. I placed handcuffs on SAEED and conducted a search for other possible weapons on him. I moved SAEED to his feet after I conducted my search and found no other weapons. I took SAEED to Squad 1490 (PO Christopher PETERSON) and placed him in the back of the Police wagon. While placing SAEED in the back of the wagon I detected the odor of an intoxicating beverage on his breath as he spoke myself and other officers about the situation.

I went back to NOVO to conduct an interview of witnesses. I interviewed a security member involved in the initial incident, who was later identified as Ricardo M. GARCIA (H/M 01-12-97).

Interview of GARCIA:

GARCIA stated that he was inside of NOVO when he noticed a commotion. GARCIA stated that he and the other members of security approached to see what the issue was. GARCIA stated that SAEED stated to him an individual touched his girlfriend's buttocks. GARCIA stated that he and the security team was able to remove all parties involved from the establishment. GARCIA stated that once outside SAEED was still yelling at security members. GARCIA stated that SHERID told SAEED "Go home before the police get involved." GARCIA stated that SAEED stated "Oh yeah? You know what I'm going to do about it?" and lifted his shirt revealing a green semi-automatic pistol in his waistband on his left hip. GARCIA stated that SHERID immediately grabbed SAEED and took him to the ground. GARCIA stated that he then went to go look for Police Officers to notify.

SAEED was conveyed by Squad 1490 to Central Booking to be processed.

I spoke with the licensee Nathan HARRIS and HARRIS asked me numerous times what he could do to help situations like these. I advised HARRIS that we would be able to talk at a later time about preventing further incidents.

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Early Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On Sunday, November 15, 2015, at our about 11:21 pm, Squad 2268 (P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ) and I was dispatched to investigate a report of a "Robbery with Force" that had occurred at the approximate address of 610 W Cleveland Av at our about 10:45 pm, on Sunday, November 15, 2015.

The two victims of this offense, along with a third party, had been patrons of "La Pasadita" tavern, located at 2691 S 6th St. The victims exited the tavern and were confronted by a second group of subjects (who had exited the premises shortly before them) who battered and robbed them before fleeing the scene. Officers made contact with the tavern and spoke to two employees, Silvia SANCHEZ (F/W 10/03/77) and Zeferino GUERRERO (M/W 08/26/68), who were able to review the video surveillance of the incident but were unable to provide a copy of the video

P.O. Efrain CORNEJO contacted the licensee, Luis LOPEZ-GONZALEZ (M/W 01/20/71), on Tuesday, November 16, 2015, who provided a copy of the video. An identification of one of the actors, Daniel GOMEZ (M/W 03/04/95), was obtained through the video provided and the subject was taken into custody. The video also depicts GOMEZ (twenty years of age) entering the premises and being served a beer after he fails to provide identification when asked.

GOMEZ did also make a statement following his arrest in which he stated that he had consumed a beer at the premises prior to being involved in a fight outside and later being arrested while in possession of one of the victim's property. GOMEZ also stated that he is a member of the "Mexican Posse" street gang.

In lieu of a citation being issued to the premises or the bartender a letter noticing the agent to enroll in the Municipal Citation Diversion Program – "Respect 21" was sent on Thursday, November 19, 2015.

This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Police Department has found your business, La Pasadita Bar, located at 2691 S 6th St, Milwaukee WI 53207 in violation of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances § 90-18-1-a-2, (Sale to Minor) AND Milwaukee Code of Ordinances § 90-18-1-a-2 (Presence of Minor at Licensed Premises) on 11/15/2015. As an individual or entity that is licensed or subject to a license in the operation of a business upon the premises, you are a responsible party for licensed-related violations that occur at your business.

The sale or offering of sale of alcohol to underage persons or persons not permitted by your alcohol license is a serious offense that may have an adverse impact on the maintenance or future issuance of your license.

In lieu of having a citation(s) issued for the above violation(s), you are eligible to enroll in a municipal citation diversion program called "Respect 21." The Mystery Shopper will attempt to enter your establishment and purchase or be served an alcoholic beverage.

In order to successfully complete Respect 21 and not have the underlying citation(s) issued, you must:

- Enroll in the program by submitting the attached form within <u>two weeks</u> of the date of this letter. There is a \$250 enrollment fee, which is less than the forfeiture amount of the citation(s);
- Successfully pass <u>all four</u> Mystery Shopper inspections; AND
- Not violate any provision of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ch. 85 (general licensing requirements), ch. 90 (liquor laws), or ch. 108 (public entertainment premises) for six months as of the date of this notice.

If you do not timely enroll in or successfully complete Respect 21, the underlying citation(s) will be issued.

In addition, the Milwaukee Police Department may issue a Licensed Premises Report for the underlying violation(s). However, if you successfully complete the Respect 21 program, a subsequent Licensed Premises Report will be issued to acknowledge that your business has enrolled in and completed this abatement program. The Milwaukee Police Department strongly encourages you to take advantage of this opportunity and enroll. Enrollment in the program is not an admission of guilt.
