This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 03/01/2015 Milwaukee police were flagged down at South Cesar E Chavez Drive and West Mineral Street regarding a shots fired complaint. The victim told officers that while she was eating inside Jalisco Restaurant (1035 South Cesar E Chavez Drive), her vehicle was struck multiple times by gun fire. Milwaukee police incident report #150600016 filed.
- 2. On 03/13/2015 Milwaukee police, while on patrol, observed two subjects arguing while outside Jalisco's Restaurant. These subjects told officers they had been at local taverns and planned on going into Jalisco's to get food. These subjects left the area without incident.
- 3. On 11/04/15, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1035 S Cesar Chavez, Jalisco's Restaurant, for a Subject with Weapon complaint. Police spoke with the manager Fidel Morales-Maccdo who stated he has a verbal argument with a patron over her take out order and that the patron was asked to leave. The patron pulled out a hand gun from her waist band and climbed through the take out window into the restaurant area and threatened him. The suspect took a food order that was not hers and that she did not pay for it and then exited the business. Security on scene then detained her until police arrived. A black BB gun was recovered from the area where the suspect was detained.

4. On 05/15/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a trouble with the subject complaint at 1035 South Cesar E. Chavez Drive. Investigation revealed an employee of the security company used by Jaliscos, pepper sprayed a group of patrons that had become offensive and disorderly.

PA-33E Narrative

This report was written by P.O. Lisa PURCELLI assigned to Squad 2321 with P.O. Jeremy GONZALEZ at District Two, Late shift.

On Sunday, May 15, 2016 at 3:55 a.m., we responded to a Trouble With Subject complaint at Jaliscos Restaurant, located at 1035 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr. The investigation revealed that a security officer (Jose L. ROSADO-ROSARIO, w/m, 10/4/84) had pepper sprayed a patron (GOMEZ, Mario A., w/m, 1/19/92) who was suspected to be intoxicated by alcohol and was being offensive and threatening towards employees. The security officer was employed by JC Public Safety and was assigned to work at Jaliscos during the their extended hours. ROSADO-ROSARIO had to call for back-up security officers from his company to respond and assist as the patron who he had sprayed, along with that patron's friends, were all being disorderly and offensive towards them, which disrupted the normal flow of business.

The manager on duty, Atanacio MAZABA-SERRANO (w/m, 7/17/88), stated he did not have access to the video surveillance system in the business, and no one would be available to assist with it until Monday, May 16, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. when the owner was due to arrive.

This investigation was pended awaiting the viewing of the video surveillance.

This report is written by PO Taylor D. BAAS, assigned to District Two, Early Shift, squad 2430 with PO Adam J. LUEBBE. On Saturday, April 30th, 2016, at approximately 1:36AM, I was dispatched to the address of 1517 S. Pearl St. for a Battery Cutting Complaint, which occurred at approximately 1:31AM in the City and County of Milwaukee. Further investigation determined the incident to be a Homicide.

On scene, I secured the scene and conducted multiple interviews. PO Oscar A. ESPITIA (Squad 2450), conducted interviews inside of The Tequila Night Club located at 1460 S. Muskego Av., where the victim had been prior to the incident.

Further investigation determined that the victim and suspect had been inside The Tequila Night Club prior to the incident. The victim had been outside The Tequila Night Club when the suspect and multiple people approached him. The victim then spit at the suspect causing a physical fight outside of The Tequila Night Club that resulted in the homicide of the vicim. The victim was previously accused of touching a girl, prior to the incident, possibly causing the fight to begin.

I attempted to do a License Premise check multiple times at The Tequila Night Club, however they were closed when I did so. On Monday, June 28th, 2016 I located a copy of the businesses license in my mail box. I reviewed the License which revealed no violations.


