

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Robert Bresette, a City of Milwaukee firefighter/paramedic, was in the scope of his employment, and a passenger in a Milwaukee Fire Department ambulance that was traveling eastbound on West Capitol Drive with emergency lights and siren activated. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Capitol Drive and North Teutonia Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding northbound on North Teutonia Avenue, failed to yield the right-of-way and struck the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

The firefighter/paramedic Bresette sustained injuries to his neck and back. The treating physicians indicated the injuries are permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$71,901.40.
