Dear Mr. Ali:

This is to notify you that on Wednesday, September 28, 2016, the City's Public Works Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council renewal, with a ten (10) day suspension of your Taxicab Permit and Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license(s) based on your testimony substantiating the complaint.

On September 30, 2016, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Public Works Committee with respect to the renewal applications for your Taxicab Permit and Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license(s) in which the Committee recommended that the license(s) be suspended for ten (10) days based on your testimony substantiating the complaint. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, October 11, 2016, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Public Works Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Works Committee, the Common Council voted to suspend for ten (10) days your Taxicab Permit and Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license(s) based on your testimony substantiating the complaint. The suspension for your Taxicab Permit is effective immediately and will be in effect until October 20, 2016. Your Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license will be suspended from November 1, 2016 through November 10, 2016.
