Budget Changes

Overall budget increased by 24.5%

- Salaries increased by 2.9%
 - Funding and 0.5 FTE included for Marketing intern
- Operating Expenditures increased by 30.1%
 - Sewer Fee cost increased by \$256,000
- Special Funds decreased by 42.9%
 - Crane debt payment (+\$185,000)
 - Increase in the Leasehold Demolition/Facilities Upgrade account (\$544,000)

Port Updates

Facility Maintenance and Upgrade

- \$1.3 million included for ongoing maintenance and improvement of Port facilities
 - Leasehold Demolition/Facilities Upgrade
 - Environmental Cleanup
 - Major Rehab and Upgrade Equipment
- \$600,000 included for capital improvements
 - \$100,000 budgeted for Pier Birth and Channel Improvements
 - \$500,000 allocated for rail track improvement
 - 5th year of rail track upgrade program

Port Updates

Revenues

- Budgeted revenues total approximately \$6 million
- Annual Port revenues exceed expenditures by approximately \$1 million
 - Transferred to general city revenue
 - Will be used to support RACM financing of the Port new crane
