




ELIGIBILITY - WHO CAN GET AN ID?

- 14 years or older (Minors must be accompanied by a guardian)
- Lived in Milwaukee 15 days
- Proof of identity
- List of acceptable "proof" documents attached to the file




PROCEDURES - HOW TO GET AN ID

- Submit application
 - In-person only
 - Spanish & Hmong translations
- Proof of identity/residency
 - Documents are not retained unless there is an appeal
- Pay fee & take photograph
- Receive ID in the mail



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- \$10 Fee (\$5 replacement fee)
- City IDs cannot be used to vote
- Denied applications may be appealed to the City Clerk
- City IDs expire in 5 years
