
Dear Attorney Hayes:

We have received your claim on behalf of Michael Allness for the amount of \$3,050.00 in relation to the property damage he sustained on July 13, 2016 at 3315 West Scott Street.

Our investigation determined that there were several different types of tire tracks crossing the concrete slab in front of your client's garage. We did not locate any large tire or track marks on the concrete slab that would indicate a City vehicle caused damage to the concrete slab.

The damage to Mr. Allness' concrete slab was not the result of any negligence of the City of Milwaukee and therefore the City is not legally liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
