

Substitute resolution approving levy-
ing of assessments and construction of
assessable public improvement projects
of various locations and appropriating
funds for these purposes with the City
cost of these projects approved by this
resolution is estimated to be \$281,400
for a total estimated cost of \$310,400.

Whereas, The Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee adopted prelimi-
nary resolutions, determining it neces-
sary and in the public interest to con-
struct and levy special assessments for
the following improvements:

2nd Aldermanic District
W. Perkins Pl. - W. Appleton
Ave. to N. 76th St. (ST21080121)
File Number 080004: Asphalt
pavement resurfacing, replace curb and
gutter, sidewalk and driveway ap-
proaches where necessary, sodding,
and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction
Paving Fund - \$6,400; Nonassessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$85,000).

The total estimated cost for this project
including the requested amount is
\$105,400. This project is anticipated to
be completed during the 2009 construc-
tion season.

4th Aldermanic District
W. Wells St. - N. 13th St. to N.
16th St. (ST21080137) File Num-
ber 080240: Install median, special
treatment (Assessable Reconstruction
Paving Fund - \$100,000).

Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving
Fund - \$90,000). The total estimated
cost for this project including the re-
quested amount is \$205,000. This proj-
ect is anticipated to be completed dur-
ing the 2008 construction season.

nent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes
and in the manner directed by Section
115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ord-
nances; and be it

Further Resolved: That the proper
departments take such action as is re-
quired of them to assess the dubiting or
odolcent properties and collect such os-
sement in the manner directed by Sec-
tion 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of
Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved: That the City
Comptroller is authorized and directed
to transfer such funds which are availa-
ble for this purpose to the appropriate
capitol Project/Grant accounts; and, be
it

Further Resolved: That the projects
do not involve any parcels of agricul-
tural land which are eligible for de-
ferred special assessments under the
provisions of Section 14.30 of the Mil-
waukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved: That the Depart-
ment of Public Works is authorized to
use the funding os specified in the
above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved: That projects W.
Perkins Pl (ST21080121) and W. Wells
St. (ST21080137) will be billed after
January 1, 2011, but not before 12
months after the project control has
been completed.
