5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

1348 E Brady Street - Qdoba, Exterior Art Design

Proposal Concept:

I was inspired primarily by the distinctive architecture of Brady Street. I created several digitally blended photographs of street views, angled roof tops and sidewalk scenes. For added interest and texture I layered in maps of Brady Street and the surrounding neighborhood. The resulting text of street names, parks, local attractions and 53202 zip code all help enhance the local urban vibe.

Materials:

Two wide format digital photo art pieces will be printed on vinyl covered with a clear vinyl UV protective laminate. They will be mounted on a 4' x 8' x 1/4" sheet of laminated metal called "Max Metal" by a professional sign company. Each art panel will be bolted to slightly larger sheets of corrugated metal to create an industrial 'frame'. The metal can be galvanized to prevent rust or left natural to age with a rust patina. The corrugated sheets will have metal tubing attached to the back for stability and will get anchored directly to the brick wall.

Maintenance:

Max Metal sign laminate is intended for outdoor use and is resistant to weather and graffiti. The expected lifespan is approximately 8-10 years with no maintenance needed. The art can potentially get sprayed with an additional anti-graffiti coating.













ART BY ANITA - Installation close up & project dimensions

Corrugated metal sheets overlap - riveted together System of metal support tubes bolted to back, 6 (or more) wall anchors in brick





Full exterior dimensions

Art panel 4' high x 8' wide 1/4" thick

Metal frame 5' 4" high x 9' 4" wide thickness ~1/2" (8" frame reveal)

Total depth ~ 3"
