Dear Ms. Brown:

We have received your claim for the amount of \$1,357.00 in relation to the forced entry occurring on August 6, 2016 at 3918 North 39th Street.

Our investigation determined the Milwaukee Police Department received a call from an unknown person stating a relative had been shot at 3918 North 39th Street. When the police arrived, they knocked on the door to gain entry. Since there was no response from any occupants, the officers forced entry into the residence to investigate the call.

The Milwaukee Police Department exercised the appropriate action in his forced entry and as such the City of Milwaukee would not be liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the
