Subject: Traffic Control Improvements South Chase/Howell Avenue from East/West Howard Avenue to East Ohio Avenue

Dear Council Members:

The 2009 Capital Improvement Program includes the improvement of South Chase/Howell Avenue from East/West Howard Avenue to East Ohio Avenue under the Surface Transportation Program. The Federal Program provides cost participation for the improvement of traffic control devices in conjunction with the highway paving.

The total estimated cost for construction of the project is \$118,598.41. One hundred percent of the total cost will be funded by the Wiscons in Department of Transportation (WISDOT).

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works and Comptroller to execute a Local Force Account (LFA) – State contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install and/or modify traffic control facilities in conjunction with the improvement of South Chase/Howell Avenue from East/West Howard Avenue to East Ohio Avenue in the 13^{th} and 14^{th} Aldermanic Districts.
