Tim,

This application is for a temporary path along the green line indicated in the diagram below. A photo of the yard in it's current state and with a mock-up of the proposed path is attached. Also attached are photos of the back steps and a rough idea of the proposed railing. As advised by the historical preservation office, I plan to use plain galvanized pipe for the railing, attached to the existing cement. I will paint it a neutral color.

This project is strictly to make the path to and from the garage acceptably safe for my family over the winter and will be replaced prior to Nov. 1, 2017 with a permanent path and replaced rear steps. I will apply separately for those projects next year.

I plan to begin work on Dec. 17th, the day after we officially close on the property. Please let me know if you can give me approval in time. Also, let me know if I need to provide anything else.
